Mayor Heineman called the meeting to order; whereupon he noted that the significant item on the agenda was for the Council to receive the canvass results of the general election held on February 7, 1978.

AGENDA ITEM 1. Canvass results of general election held on February 7, 1978, and declare results of election.

At this point City Manager Patterson read into the record the results of the canvassing board composed of the City Attorney, City Clerk, and himself. Mayor Heineman presented the report to Council for their consideration.

Mr. Thornton made a motion to accept and approve the official report of the canvassing board on the results of the February 7, 1978 election, seconded by Mr. McGrath and carried unanimously by voice vote, with Mr. Blanquart and Mr. Holland being absent and not voting.

Prior to swearing in the new Mayor and Councilmen, Mayor Heineman asked the two retiring councilmen present if they had any remarks.

Mr. McGregor made a short statement to wish the successors the best of luck, hoping they would have the same enjoyment and the same support that departing members had received.

Mrs. Corkran stated that her term had been a great experience and she wished the remaining members the best of success and congratulations to those newly elected.

At Mayor Heineman's invitation Mr. McGrath and Mr. Thornton made statements of farewell to the retiring members of the Council and the Mayor.

At this point the Mayor and retiring Council members were presented with plaques commemorating their tenure of service to the City of Naples.

Mayor Heineman then congratulated Roland B. Anderson on his being the new Mayor and he extended his congratulations in turn to Edward Twerdahl, Wade Schroeder and Ken Wood. He went on to congratulate the unsuccessful candidates in this election and he noted that it took courage, time and devotion to undertake the running for public office. He wished to express his appreciation to Mr. McGregor, Mrs. Corkran and Mr. Blanquart for their participation in the affairs of this Council. He noted the accomplishments he felt were achieved during their terms of office.

AGENDA ITEM 2. Swearing in of New Mayor and Council persons.

Judge Charles Carlton came forward to administer the oath of office to the newly elected Mayor and Council persons.

Mayor Anderson requested that each new Councilman say a few words; whereupon, each made a short statement.

Mayor Anderson added a brief statement, saying they would all be good listeners and fast learners.

There being no further business to come before this Special Meeting of Naples City Council, Mayor Anderson declared it adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
