Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

AGENDA ITEM 1. PUBLIC HEARING to consider adoption of the final budget and millage rate levy.

Mayor Anderson opened the Public Hearing at 7:38 p.m. Janie Byrd, citizen, spoke in support of restrooms and lighting at Anthony Park to which the City Manager replied that plans for the restrooms had been completed and the project is out to bid. The Mayor noted that consideration would be given to lighting. Herb Cambridge, citizen, spoke in support of the improvements at Anthony Park and against fees being charged for the use of the Multi-purpose Center at Fleischmann Park. Rev. Rohrer again asked that extension of First Avenue South be included in this year's proposed budget. Viola Stewart, citizen, spoke in support of this matter and Messrs. Waldron, Penstone, Ornum, Smith and Stafford, citizens, spoke against it. Mr. Waldron presented a petition, in addition to one presented November 7, 1980, for the record (Attachment #1) against the request. Janie Byrd spoke again noting her opinion that more fire hydrants were needed in the Gordon River area. There being no one else to speak for or against the proposed budget and millage rate levy, the Mayor closed the Public Hearing at 8:55 p.m.

AGENDA ITEM 1-a. A resolution determining and fixing the 1980 tax levy and millage rate for the purpose of providing sufficient funds for the general obligation improvement bond indebtedness.

City Manager Patterson read the above titled resolution in its entirety; whereupon Mr. Thornton moved adoption of Resolution 3667, seconded by Mr. Twerdahl and carried on roll call vote, 7-0.

AGENDA ITEM 1-b. A resolution adopting the final budget for the fiscal year 1980-81; and providing an effective date.

City Manager Patterson read the above captioned resolution in its entirety; whereupon

Mr. Schroeder moved to adopt Resolution 3668, seconded by Mr. Twerdahl. Mr. Rothchild moved to amend the motion by adding RD 84-1 - extension of First Avenue South to the proposed budget, seconded by Mr. Holland and motion failed on roll call vote 2-5 with Councilmen Schroeder, Thornton, Twerdahl and Wood and Mayor Anderson voting no. Mr. Schroeder's motion carried on roll call vote, 6-1 with Mr. Rothchild voting no.

AGENDA ITEM 2. An ordinance determining and fixing the 1980 tax levy and millage rate for the purpose of providing sufficient funds for the general obligation improvement bond indebtedness. Purpose: To fix the 1980 tax levy. (First Reading)

City Manager Patterson read the above referenced ordinance by title for Council's consideration on First Reading; whereupon Mr. Thornton moved adoption of this ordinance on First Reading, seconded by Mr. Schroeder and carried on roll call vote, 7-0.

AGENDA ITEM 3. An ordinance adopting the final budget for the fiscal year 1980-81, and appropriating funds for operating expenses of the City of Naples for the general operation of the several governmental departments of the City, including its utilities, and for contributing to the sinking funds of the City to pay interest on and provide for the retirement of the outstanding bonds and other fixed obligations of the City, for the utility tax funds, for and during the fiscal year 1980-81; and providing an effective date. Purpose: To adopt the budget and appropriate funds for the fiscal year 1980-81. (First Reading)

City Manager Patterson read the above titled ordinance by title for Council's consideration on First Reading; whereupon Mr. Schroeder moved adoption of this ordinance on First Reading, seconded by Mr. Twerdahl and carried on roll call vote, 6-1 with Mr. Rothchild voting no, because of his opposition to the portion under Streets and Drainage.

There being no further business to come before this Special Meeting of the Naples City Council, Mayor Anderson adjourned the meeting at 9:10 p.m.
