Community Development Director Barry informed Council that Zayre's had applied for a temporary use permit for the trailers. (See Attachment #6). He went on to say that because the trailers were being used for storage, they did not qualify for a temporary permit. (See Attachment #7). Mr. Barry recommended that such trailers not be approved but be allowed to remain to July 31. He also suggested that Zayre's be given notice not to do it again. Mr. Graver expressed concern over the situation. He asked why Zayre's needed until July 31st. Mr. Barnett suggested fining them. Mr. Graver said that it was wrong for Zayre's to bring in two trailers, then ask for approval. Mr. Bledsoe asked how this came to the attention of Council. Mr. Barry said the Zoning Officer found it. Mayor Putzell asked if this was their first offense. Mr. Barry replied that they had had the trailers there once before, but also had a permit. Storage Trailers

DATE:

July 8, 1986

Background:

ZAYRE has two truck trailers parked on the north side of its business in the Naples Shopping Center, which are being used for the storage of merchandise. The trailers were moved onto the site in the middle of June. ZAYRE then requested staff to approve a temporary use permit, which we denied, because in our opinion the requested use did not qualify as a "temporary promotional activity."

ZAYRE explained that they could not remove the trailers until July 31, 1986 and submitted the attached request under the "temporary building or structure" provision of the Zoning Ordinance, which requires City Council approval.

Staff Recommendation:

We recommend that City Council approve this request and permit the trailers to remain on site until July 31, 1986, but that ZAYRE be put on notice that similar requests will not be considered or approved in the future.

The truck trailers are unattractive and having them on site for merchandise storage purposes is contrary to the intent of the Zoning Ordinance - which requires that all such merchandise be stored in and sold from an enclosed building.

Proposed Development of Regional Impact (DRI)

DATE: July 10, 1986

Background:

The Collier Development Corporation is proposing a major 2000 acre project on property located south and east of Bayview Park. A portion of the property immediately south of Bayview Park is located in the city.

The Development of Regional Impact review process is now at a point where the developer has completed his application for development approval and has so notified the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council (SWFRPC).

We expect to receive notice from the SWFRPC before the City Council meeting of July 16, 1986 so that we must now set a public hearing date to consider the application for development approval.

In order to meet state requirements and to coordinate this effort with the SWFRPC and Collier County, we propose the following review and public hearing schedule:

- July 16, 1986 City Council sets public hearing date of 11/5/86
- July 17, 1986 City forwards notice of public hearing date to SWFRPC
- Sept. 18, 1986 SWFRPC holds public meeting and adopts DRI assessment report
- Sept. 25, 1986 City to receive adopted report from SWFRPC no later than this date
- Oct. 2, 1986 Planning Advisory Board (PAB) to hold public hearing and to submit recommendation to City Council
- Oct. 15, 1986 City Council to consider PAB recommendation and consider an ordinance at first reading that would adopt a development order
- Nov. 5, 1986 City Council to hold a public hearing and to consider an ordinance at second reading that would adopt a development order

North 200'of the West 330' of Lot 63,

Naples Improvement Company's Little Farms

BACKGROUND: Over the past several months we have been in the process of reviewing a requested sewer main connection for North 200' of the West 330' of Lot 63, Naples Improvement Company's Little Farms, formerly J. P.'s Restaurant.

Resolution 85-4665, passed on February 6, 1985, provided certain determinations for City Council to review and act upon regarding sewer extensions.

ANALYSIS: The determinations referred to above are as follows:

- 1. TREATMENT CAPACITY REQUIRED: The proposed restaurant would generate a maximum flow of 10,000 gallons per day (G.P.D.).
- 2. TIME OF CONNECTION: Time of connection would be in the next several months and flows would be generated when project is completed.
- 3. CURRENT TREATMENT PLANT RATE: The wastewater treatment plant is currently treating 5.0 M.G.D.

Staff has reviewed the request and has approved it based on the following:

- l. The estimated flows can be accommodated by the existing force mains and lift stations in the area. Wilson, Miller, Barton, Soll and Peek have provided sufficient data to substantiate this excess system capacity.
- 2. All construction materials and methods will comply with both City and County standards.

RECOMMENDATION: I respectfully request City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the above referenced sewer main connection.
