and proposed and that the City had an on-going budget which includes programs from previous years (Mr. Williams' comments also addressed Items 1-b and 1-c).

City Manager Jones explained that Mr. Crawford had already suggested the same budget procedures as Mr. Williams for next year. He added that with Naples' excessive growth rate, there is a greater demand on the City for added services.

Citizen Helen Stormer asked about the increased assessment of her home and was advised by Mayor Putzell to contact the County Tax Assessor who is responsible for this.

Mayor Putzell expressed his concern that the budget was not adequately presented to the public and Mr. Crawford added his concern that essentially all of the budget for 1985-86 had been spent. Mr. Crawford also noted that the greatest increase in the coming year's budget would be the water storage facility. Mr. Bledsoe, however, pointed out that the City budget (millage rate) had not increased in many years. Mrs. Anderson-McDonald expressed her wish that anyone with questions or comments also attend the Council's budget workshops in the future..

City Attorney Rynders advised that the public was notified of the preliminary budget in accordance with state statute.
