RESOLUTION AWARDING BID FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE CAMBIER PARK BANDSHELL.

Note: The City Council began informal discussion of this item at 10:40 a.m. and, upon approval of City Attorney Rynders, called the meeting to order at 10:55 a.m., the published meeting time being 11:00 a.m.

Mr. Jones said that because of efforts to "fast-track" completion of the bandshell, the special meeting was called to act on the award of bid as soon as possible.

The award is recommended to the low bidder with the addition of the sound system alternate, Mr. Jones advised. A completion date of April 1 or 2 was specified at a pre-bid conference and none of the contractors indicated a problem with this. Prices are well within the budget, he said, and the staff was well pleased with the responses received. Total award would be \$137,578.

Mayor Putzell stated that the \$25,000 matching grant would be received because of sufficient additional contributions. He suggested that other alternates in the bids be considered, but Mr. Jones advised that the cost would actually be at the \$150,000 estimated amount when design services were added.

With reference to the sound system alternate, Mr. Jones said the staff felt it was a reasonable amount when compared to the cost of installing it after construction.

Mr. Jones complimented the staff, the engineer, and the selection committee for their efforts in expediting this project.

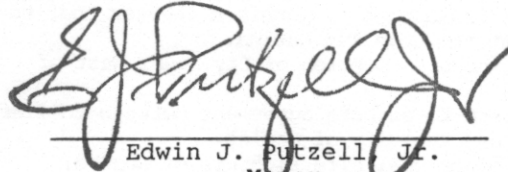

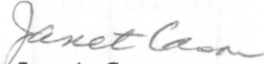

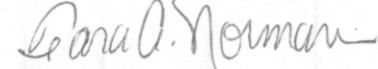
After the meeting was officially called to order at 10:55 a.m., Mayor Putzell reviewed the discussion and the item presented in resolution form. (The resolution was not read.)
