He told the audience that there is an engineering study in progress concerning a storm water utility. Other topics mentioned by the Mayor included annexation, next year's budget, and the Central Core Study which was established to determine ways to better ensure the financial success of Naples downtown area.

City Manager Jones informed the audience that the City's two priorities this year are to endeavor to find ways to accomplish more at a reasonable cost to residents and to improve the quality of service to the citizens of Naples. He explained that the City will be implementing a quality improvement
