Mr. Remington continued that the Building Department permit fees do not adequately cover costs associated with that department's personnel and operation. The local contractors, he noted, have agreed to an increase of building permit fees to help fund a new staff position so that the plan review process becomes more streamlined. City Manager Jones advised that staff could review that department in the next 90 days to see if changes made by the new Building Official have sped up the review process before increasing the permit fees. Mrs. Sue B. Smith of 15 11th Avenue South said that she did not believe the number of studies funded through the budget were necessary. She said that many of the studies could be deleted from the budget, such as, the citizens survey relative to a voluntary historic district ordinance. Ms. Smith further said that she believed the City's equipment purchase policy needed some revision.

Councilman Herms asked if the items requested by Council to be deleted from the budget were, in fact, removed. City Manager Jones advised that each item deleted by consensus of Council was reflected in the ordinance under Item 3-b.

Referring then to a project on Goodlette-Frank Road contained in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget, Councilman Herms said that he believed the estimate for fill was excessive. City Manager Jones advised that he would review the estimate and report his findings to Council.

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
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
