The City Clerk then reviewed the ballot, comprised of one Mayoral candidate and eight candidates for City Council. The ballot is in Spanish as well as English, as required by law. Mrs. Cason assured Council that the Spanish section of the ballot had been verified by the Office of Elections.

City Clerk Cason announced that the polls would be open at 7:00 a.m. and would close at 7:00 p.m. on February 4, 1992. Immediately following the closing of the polls, tallies will be handled at the County Courthouse Complex. Mrs. Cason extended an invitation to all candidates to visit the facilities while votes are being counted. Candidates will be escorted either by the City Clerk or by Supervisor of Elections, Mary Morgan.

The City Clerk next informed Council that there would be some changes in polling places and that updated precinct maps had been distributed to each Council Member's.
