**Item 7-a - Special Events - Tropicool**

Chairman of the Special Events Committee, Tara Norman, reviewed this year's Tropicool schedule, noting that proceeds from the Great Dock Canoe Race would go to the Collier County Museum. Ms. Norman assured Council that should there be any cost to the City, those requests would first come to Council for approval.

Discussion ensued with respect to the various events. It was the consensus of Council that the Cypress Garden Show would not be allowed.



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<p>City Attorney Chiaro noted that in order to avoid any questions with respect to the Sunshine Law, all of the Task Force meetings should be advertised. Council Member Pennington suggested that the Task Force Committee Members be given some standard directions as to Sunshine Law regulations.</p> <p>Council Member Herms commented that over the past ten years the City had compiled many plans that were never acted upon. He said he hoped to see an actual redevelopment plan that goes through with the consensus of everyone in the community. <u>Mr. Herms suggested that the Committee be encouraged to work with the community and to involve members of the business community and property owners immediately. He suggested making contact with such people through the media, mailings, etc.</u></p> <p>City Manager Woodruff reviewed Section 1 of the Redevelopment Task Force Mission Statement. Extending the Mission Statement's timetable was discussed. <u>It was the consensus of Council that Phase I of the Mission Statement would be extended to June 15, 1992 and Phase II extended to September 15, 1992.</u> It was agreed that the agenda for each Task Force meeting would have a section entitled "Public Input."</p> <p>A resolution, setting up the Redevelopment Task Force Committee and specifying its members will be prepared for Council's approval at the Regular Meeting on March 4, 1992.</p> <p>***</p>
