3. Discussion of Investment Advisor.
A selection committee to include Council Member Sullivan, Finance Director Harrison, and Charles White of Compass Bank, Birmingham, Alabama, will develop a Request For Proposal to be sent to investment advisors. The committee will review the respondents and report back to Council.
4. Beachfront properties - discussion of scope of work program.
It was the consensus of Council that staff should proceed with its scope of work on the beachfront subdivision study. Council will reassess the scope of work in early April, 1995.
5. Proposed changes to text and process for variances.
