Council Member Prolman requested the City Clerk add a line on the candidates' applications asking them to list any alternate committees they would consider for appointment.
INTERVIEWS WITH CANDIDATES FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD. (8:37 a.m.) Council interviewed Clark Russell. Clark Richards was not present when called.
There was a discussion with the City Clerk Tara Norman clarifying the number of vacancies and reappointment for board positions.
Mayor Barnett noted the Special Workshop would reconvene following the Regular Meeting.

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Development Services Director Richard Gatti explained to Council that the Gateway Committee had been developing ideas for bridge enhancements, noting that the challenge had been to incorporate the committee's ideas into a set of pre-established plans. Director Gatti informed Council that bids for the project will be received on May 21, and the construction would begin on August 1, 1997. He indicated the contractor was required to complete the work in 635 days.

Allen Trump, of dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precouart, Inc., described the project and used transparencies and photographs to depict the anticipated results. (Copies of the photographs and transparencies are contained in the file for this meeting in the City Clerk's office.) Mr. Gatti related to Council that the City would pay the differences between the proposed plans and the bid plans. He said these items

included the landscaping and gatehouses.

Council directed Mr. Gatti to explore designs for a bike path that would be an alternative to a path which is separated merely by a solid paint stripe.
