City Council Special Meeting – September 17, 2008 – 5:04 p.m.

Mayor Barnett called the meeting to order and presided.

Public Comment: (5:07 p.m.) Mark Steiner, AFSCME Union representative, questioned whether, in light of economic projections, additional employee layoffs would not in fact occur in the next budget cycle as well; he therefore urged that the roll-back rate, plus 4% be considered. Carolyn Teal, 4201 32nd Avenue SW, as one of the City employees to lose their positions, noted that her duties had become the responsibility of someone receiving a higher hourly rate than hers and questioned the wisdom of this decision. Sue Smith, 11th Avenue South, stated that she believed that budget trimming could have been done without the loss of employees; she also questioned whether Council should continue with its practice of a two-month summer recess.

In response to Vice Mayor Taylor, Community Services Director David Lykins explained that although the funding for the interlocal agreement with Collier County School District for the use of the Gulfview Middle School gymnasium had been omitted from the budget under consideration, and thereby saving approximately \$100,000, an all-encompassing agreement remains in effect wherein the City and its residents can continue to use such facilities without additional costs. The summer basketball program would continue, he assured Council.

Title read by City Manager William Moss (5:20 p.m.). Council Member Price indicated that he would not support the budget as proposed due to the belief that retaining employees should have been more of a priority, that other areas of the budget could have been more closely scrutinized with regard to cost savings. Furthermore, he said, he did not believe enough had been removed from the proposal under consideration to safeguard the coming year's budget. Cuts must begin at the top he said, reiterating his belief that the Council's level of compensation should also have been reviewed.
