SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTINUING CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT (the "Second Amendment") to the Continuing Contract for Professional Services is made and entered into this 23rd day of January, 2008 by and between the CITY OF NAPLES, a Florida Municipal Corporation (the "City"), and Kris Jain & Associates, Inc. (the "Consultant").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into that certain Agreement to furnish Engineering Services dated 9th day of September, 2005 (Res. 05-10930) (the "Original Agreement") certain design services for three City of Naples Building Facilities ('Project'); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement by this Second Amendment so that the Consultant will provide additional services pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and conditions herein set forth, it is hereby acknowledged and agreed as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this Reference.
- 2. The scope of services shall be amended in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for the provision of additional services by the Consultant in the amount not-to-exceed \$8,145.00 to provide additional professional engineering services for improvements to Equipment Services and the Wastewater Collections Warehouse ('Project').
- 3. Article Four "Time" shall be amended to allow for additional services for an additional 120 days through August 31, 2008.
- 4. The terms of this Second Amendment shall control and take precedence over any and all terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement which might vary, contradict or otherwise be inconsistent with the terms and conditions hereof. All of the other terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement, except as expressly amended and modified by this Second Amendment, shall remain unchanged and are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. This Second Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original as against any part whose signature appears thereon and all of which shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

We request approval of fees incurred by us in Additional Engineering Services necessary during the process of obtaining construction permits by the Contractor on the above two City projects.

These services were beyond our basic scope of services and are considered unanticipated Additional Engineering Services. The City PM is well aware that prior to the bids the design plans had passed a preliminary Fire Protection and other plan review by the building department. However, when the final bid plans were submitted for permits, numerous unnecessary fire protection, plumbing, ventilation and facility questions and rejection comments were raised. All these objections and rejection comments had to be discussed and resolved with the permit staff, the plans revised and resubmitted for permits, thus resulting in additional engineering time. Most of the objections and comments were found unnecessary and ruled out. In the interest of time and to expedite the permit process, the necessary additional services were performed in anticipation of the additional fee approval.
