### SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT (the "Second Amendment") to the Continuing Contract for Professional is made and entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2012 by and between the CITY OF NAPLES, a Florida Municipal Corporation (the "City"), and Wilson Miller, Inc (the "Consultant").

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into that certain Agreement to furnish Contract for Professional Services, dated September 7, 2011 (Tracking # 11-00036 (the "Original Agreement") for services associated with Design and Permitting for the City of Naples Recycle Transfer Facility ('Project'); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement by this Second Amendment so that the Consultant will provide additional services pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and conditions herein set forth, it is hereby acknowledged and agreed as follows:

- The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this Reference.
- 2. "Article Three Section 3.1, Time" shall be amended for the provision of additional time by the Consultant with a completion date of completed 365 days from the notice to proceed.
- 3. "Article Five, Compensation" shall be amended for the provision of additional fees by the Consultant in the amount of \$76,000.00 for engineering services related to construction administration/management of the recycle facility (**EXHIBIT A**).
- 4. The terms of this Second Amendment shall control and take precedence over any and all terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement which might vary, contradict or otherwise be inconsistent with the terms and conditions hereof. All of the other terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement, except as expressly amended and modified by this Second Amendment, shall remain unchanged and are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. This Second Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original as against any part whose signature appears thereon and all of which shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City and the Contractor have caused this Second Amendment to be duly executed by their duly authorized officers, all as of the day and year first above written.

### City of Naples Recycle Transfer Facility - Construction Phases Services

### 2 SCOPE of SERVICES:

### 2.1 Site-Civil and Limited Landscape Architecture Construction Phase Services

### (Billing Task 420.100)

- 2.1.1 Project Management Assistance and Utility Provider Coordination
  - Assist the City of Naples in project management and coordination of the project. Coordination may be performed on a regular basis and the intent is to assist City of Naples staff in managing the Contractor, Design Team and any other consultants retained through the construction phase of the project.

Notes: WilsonMiller does not have the authority to issue or approve contract change orders for work assignments performed by consultants who may be contracted directly with the City of Naples.

WilsonMiller does not have the authority to issue change directives on the design, construction documents or dictate construction means and methods without prior written consent from the City of Naples.

- Attend up to two (2) coordination meetings with utility providers (FPL, Centurylink, Comcast, etc.).
- Provide construction documents and design information to facilitate utility provider's design for supporting services.

### (Billing Task 420.200)

### 2.1.2 Coordination and Meetings

- Attend one (1) kick-off meetings with client and contractor(s).
- Attend up to two (2) pre-construction meetings with regulatory agencies (City of Naples, SFWMD, FDEP Water, Wastewater and Solid/Hazardous Waste Departments and Naples Airport Authority), Client and contractor(s).
- Prepare and submit SFWMD's Construction Commencement Notice, as required per the permit conditions.
- Attend up to twelve (12) coordination meetings within a 12 month period with Client, consultant team, contractor(s) and contractor's team to discuss construction activities, progress and to address any site related issues that may arise.
- Attend meetings with Client, contractor and regulatory agencies, as requested and deemed necessary.
- Respond to questions and RFIs submitted by the contractor(s) or contractor's team during the course of construction.

### 2.1.3 General Conformance Review

Review shop drawings for conformance with design concepts provided within the WilsonMiller construction documents and technical specifications.

Note: This scope of service incudes up to two shop drawing reviews. Additional shop drawings reviews have not been considered in estimated fee budget.

### Attachment B - WilsonMiller Scope of Services

## City of Naples Recycle Transfer Facility – Construction Management and Construction Completion Services

Conduct periodic site visits to observe progress of on-going construction and verify improvements are constructed in general accordance with the WilsonMiller construction documents and technical specifications. Based on those site visits, prepare and submit construction observation reports to Client, contractor(s) and contractor's team.

Note: Adequate number of site visits must be conducted by WilsonMiller in order to provide certificates of substantial completion, as noted under section 2.1.3.

Review pay applications submitted by the general contractor and provide recommendations of approval for payment.

Note: WilsonMiller will only review and provide recommendations of approval for construction items which WilsonMiller is the Engineer of Record.

### 2.1.4 Certifications and Substantial Completion Services

- Observe and review test results for preparation of the required site-civil engineer and landscape certifications.
- Coordinate with contractor(s) and contractor's professional land surveyor, and generate record drawings based on submitted as-built drawings.

Note: As-built drawings must be certified by the contractor's licensed and registered professional land surveyor

- Coordinate and conduct preliminary and final site visits with regulatory agencies, client and contractor(s) to achieve certifications of substantial completion from regulatory agencies.
- Prepare punch lists identifying corrective actions required.
- Prepare, submit and support certifications of substantial completion and occupancy approvals from SFWMD and City of Naples.

Note: Certifications to FDEP have been excluded. Reference General Conditions and Understandings, Paragraph 3.5.

Prepare final turn-over package to client and contractor(s) in accordance with construction documents, including record drawings (in electronic format), recommended storm water maintenance program, permit and construction plans, etc.

### 2.2 Construction Phase Reimbursable Expenses

### (Billing Task 430)

Expenses for blueprints, reproduction services, database searches, color graphics, and overnight express and regular delivery services shall be reimbursable to WilsonMiller.

### Attachment B - WilsonMiller Scope of Services

City of Naples Recycle Transfer Facility – Construction Management and Construction Completion Services

### 3 CONSTRUCTION PHASE CONDITIONS AND UNDERSTANDINGS:

- 3.1 The scope and fee of this proposal is based on a site construction duration schedule of no more than 12 months.
- 3.2 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client's Contractor will include as-built drawings certified by a professional land surveyor licensed and registered in the state of Florida. Content of the as-built drawings will include all information as noted within the construction documents, technical specifications, and City of Naples Specification and Utilities Standards Manual.
- 3.3 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client's Contractor will include all geotechnical services, as noted within the construction documents, technical specifications, and City of Naples Specification and Utilities Standards Manual. Services shall be performed by a professional geotechnical engineer, licensed and registered in the state of Florida.
- 3.4 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client's Contractor will be responsible for submitting NPDES NOI and NOT Permits, and for providing, implementing and maintaining a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) on-site during the course of construction.
- 3.5 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client's Contractor will be responsible for the preparation of a Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plan and/or Access Management Plan for any of the surrounding roads.
- 3.6 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client (City of Naples Public Utilities Department) will conduct and witness all testing for the proposed potable water and wastewater facilities, and prepare all information necessary for submittal of certificates of construction completion required by FDEP.
- 3.7 The scope and fee of this proposal assumes the Client (City of Naples Public Utilities Department) will be responsible in any coordination or submittal of any permit modifications with the FDEP Solid Waste and Hazardous Materials Department.

### 4 CONSTRUCTION PHASE EXCLUDED SERVICES:

- 4.1 Services related to any major redesign or revisions to the construction documents due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 4.2 Services related to construction phase surveying services, including but not limited to, construction stake-out, final record (as-built drawings certified by a registered land surveyor) and slab surveys and flood certificates for building and structures.

### 2.1 Architecture, Structural and MEP Construction Phase Services

During construction the Consultant shall review the work during construction for compliance with the Architect's approved and permitted construction documents. Construction services are generally described and will include, and will be limited to, the following;

- 2.1.2 Reviewing material and equipment submittals for the project.
- 2.1.3 Shop drawing review.

Note: This scope of service incudes up to two shop drawing reviews. Additional shop drawings reviews have not been considered in estimated fee budget.

- 2.1.4 Responding to Contractor's questions and/or providing clarifications to scope of work.
- 2.1.5 Conduct periodic site visits.

Notes: Structural, Mechanical, and Electrical consultant shall conduct periodic site observations coordinated with the stage of construction, as deemed appropriate and coordinated by the Architect.

Number of site visits for building construction duration and considered in estimated fee budget, include:

Architect: 12 visits (bi-weekly for up to 6 months)

Structural: 6 visits MEP: 2 visits

- 2.1.6 Reviewing contractor payment applications.
- 2.1.7 Developing one punch list walk through, one final walk through.

### (Billing Task 431)
