

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
(SERVICES)**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (the "First Amendment") to the Contract for Services is made and entered into this 17th day of February, 2015 by and between the **CITY OF NAPLES**, a Florida Municipal Corporation (the "City"), and **T.L.C. DIVERSIFIED, INCORPORATED** a Florida Profit Corporation (the Contractor").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor entered into that certain Agreement to furnish Contract for Services, dated **February 19, 2014** (the "Original Agreement") (Reference Original Bid No. **ITB 14-012** and Original Clerk **Tracking No. 14-00011** for services associated with **Water Treatment Plant Thickener Tank Rehabilitation: First Amendment: Additional Time** ('Project'); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement by this First Amendment so that the Contractor **will be provided additional time** pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and conditions herein set forth, it is hereby acknowledged and agreed as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this Reference.
2. "Article Three, Time" shall be amended to **September 30, 2015** with a allowed project closeout timeframe of December 31, 2015 for the provision of additional time the Contractor will have for the completion and close out of the Project, **Water Treatment Plant Thickener Tank Rehabilitation**.
3. The terms of this First Amendment shall control and take precedence over any and all terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement which might vary, contradict or otherwise be inconsistent with the terms and conditions hereof. All of the other terms, provisions and conditions of Original Agreement, except as expressly amended and modified by this First Amendment, shall remain unchanged and are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original as against any part whose signature appears thereon and all of which shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
