AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE AND SALE OF GOODS

THIS AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE AND SALE OF GOODS (the "Agreement") is made this day of December 2015, by and between STEELE TRUCK CENTER, INC., a Florida Profit Corporation whose address is 2150 Rockfill Road; Fort Myers, Florida 33916 ("Seller") and THE CITY OF NAPLES, a Florida Municipal Corporation, the address of which is 735 Eighth Street South, Naples, Florida 34102 ("Buyer"). In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby mutually acknowledged, Buyer and Seller agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Description of Goods; Sale and Delivery</u>. Seller shall sell, transfer, and deliver to Buyer the goods described in each order placed based off of **Attachment A-1** pricing structure which is attached and made part of this Agreement and as stated in **Proposal RFP 16-003** herein referenced and made a part of this Agreement and as subject to such terms as are set forth in the Proposal and in this Agreement.
- 2. <u>Acceptance; Purchase</u>. Buyer shall accept the goods and pay an amount that is not to exceed the negotiated cost of each ordered Heavy-Duty Large Commercial Truck ordered in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and shall be paid in the manner set forth in this Agreement.
- 3. <u>Identification of Goods</u>. Identification of the goods shall not be deemed to have been made until both Buyer and Seller have agreed that the goods in question are to be appropriate to each ordered Heavy-Duty Large Commercial Truck and in accordance with the performance of this Agreement.
- 4. Rate and Time of Payment. Unless otherwise specified, Buyer shall make payment to Seller for the goods within thirty (30) days after the goods are received by Buyer.
- 5. Receipt of Goods. The goods shall be deemed received by Buyer when delivered to the Buyer at City of Naples; Attention: Utilities Department; 370 Riverside Circle; Naples, Florida 34102. Delivery of the goods and services to Buyer shall occur as outlined in each ordered Heavy-Duty Large Commercial Truck.
- 6. Risk of Loss. The risk of loss from any casualty to the goods, regardless of the cause, shall be on Seller up to the time of receipt of the goods by the Buyer at the place of delivery, but only after any proper inspection has been completed without rejection of the goods. Thereafter, such risk shall be on Buyer, including any goods thereafter returned to Seller until their receipt by the Seller.
- Warranty Against Encumbrances. Seller warrants that the goods are now free, and at the time of delivery shall be free, from any security interest or other lien or encumbrance.

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- 8. Warranty of Title. Seller warrants that at the time of signing this Agreement or at time of delivery, Seller neither knows, nor has reason to know, of the existence of any outstanding title or claim of title hostile to the rights of Seller of the goods.
- 9. <u>Product Warranty</u>. Seller provides general warranties of fitness and general warranties that the goods are free from defects, for 1 year from acceptance of the goods, except as may otherwise be set forth in the Description/Proposal, or other attached warranty: Manufacturer's warranty will apply. Seller shall provide all warranty documentation at time of delivery.
- 10. <u>Right of Inspection</u>. Buyer shall have the right to inspect the goods at the time and place of delivery, and within five (5) business days after delivery, Buyer must give notice to Seller of any claim for damages on account of the condition, quality, or grade of the goods, and Buyer must specify in detail the basis of such claim. The failure of Buyer to comply with these conditions shall constitute irrevocable acceptance of the goods by Buyer.
- 11. <u>Procedure as to Rejected Goods</u>. On receipt of notification of rejection, Seller will immediately arrange to receive back the goods for shipment and return. However, within five (5) days, Seller may have an agent inspect such goods for nonconformity; otherwise, such inspection will be made on return to Seller's facility. When such goods are confirmed or acquiesced as nonconforming, Seller will ship conforming goods within thirty (30) days of the notice of rejection unless Buyer earlier notifies Seller to forgo such shipment.
- 12. Governing Law. The parties acknowledge that the transaction that is the subject matter of this Agreement bears a reasonable relation to the State of Florida and agree that the law of the State of Florida will govern their rights and duties. The parties specifically intend that the provisions of Article 2 of the Florida Uniform Commercial Code will control as to all aspects of this Agreement and its interpretation, except Software, and that all the definitions contained therein will be applicable to this Agreement except where this Agreement may expressly provide otherwise.

- 14. <u>Description/Proposal Documents</u>. The terms and conditions of (RFP) Request for Proposal No. 16-003 which is herein referenced and made a part hereof shall be incorporated herein as a part of this Agreement.
- 15. <u>Notices and Address of Record</u>. All notices required or made pursuant to this Agreement to be given by Seller to Buyer shall be in writing and shall be delivered by overnight courier, by hand or by the (USPS) United States Postal Service, first class mail service, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, or as otherwise agreed upon and addressed to the following:

- 17. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Agreement shall commence on 12/02/2015 and be valid through 12/31/2018 and shall have with mutual agreement of the Seller and Buyer the option for (2) two 1/year renewal options.
