

**(TO) TASK ORDER AMENDMENT TO CSC AGREEMENT
(PROFESSIONAL CCNA SERVICES)**

THIS TASK ORDER AMENDMENT (the "Amendment") to the (CSC) Continuing Services Contract for Professional CCNA Services is made and entered into effective the 30th day of November 2015, by and between the **CITY OF NAPLES**, a Florida Municipal Corporation (the "City"), and **TETRA TECH, INCORPORATED**, a Delaware Corporation (the Consultant").

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into that certain Agreement to furnish CCNA Services, on **May 19, 2015** (the "Original Agreement") (Reference Original **RFQ 14-054** and Original **Clerk Tracking No.15-00090**). This Task Order Amendment is associated with the **(WWTP) Waste Water Treatment Plant As-Needed Services: Task Order No. 16-01-30-40-546000**: the ('Project'); and


WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement by this Task Order Amendment so that the Consultant will provide said services pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Original Agreement and Amendment herein.

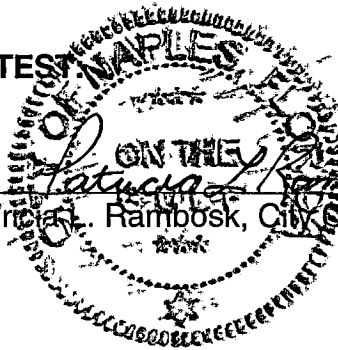
NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and conditions herein set forth, it is hereby acknowledged and agreed as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this Reference.
2. "Article Three, Time" is amended to state that this Project Task Order Amendment will be performed and completed by **September 30, 2016** with a 30-day Project close-out time frame. Project: (WWTP) Waste Water Treatment Plant As-Need Services:
3. "Article Four, Compensation" is amended to reflect an increase to the Consultant for this Task Order Amendment in the amount of **\$9,900.00** for the Project as indicated in **Attachment A-1 Scope of Services and Basis of Compensation**, attached and made a part of this Amendment.
4. All other terms, provisions and conditions of the Original Agreement, except as expressly amended and modified by this Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original as against any part whose signature appears thereon and all of which shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit our professional services proposal to assist the City of Naples on an as-needed basis at the Naples Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP).

This proposal contains our understanding of the project requirements, proposed scope of services, and fee estimate.

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

It is our understanding the City would like engineering and programming assistance at the WWTP. Examples of services we offer but not limited too under this contract are listed below:

- Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) and Human Machine Interface software programming
- Electrical and instrumentation engineering services
- Systems integration
- Onsite troubleshooting

SCOPE OF SERVICES

This contract will allow Tetra Tech to investigate, design, program and implement items as directed by Owner on an as-needed basis for a total of approximately 60 hours for staff noted above including one 3-day onsite visit. If the stated budget is exceeded Tetra Tech will not proceed without your prior written authorization.

ASSUMPTIONS

This contract assumes that the City of Naples WWTP obtains the ability and will allow Tetra Tech SCADA system access via remote electronic connection similar to the Naples Water Treatment Plant. The remote connection will allow our staff to provide quick response to SCADA programming needs and will reduce unnecessary travel costs.

SCHEDULE

Scheduling for these tasks can occur immediately following your notice to proceed and signature of this contract.

COMPENSATION


Compensation for the professional services required for the assignment will be based on time and material at a not-to-exceed fee budget of \$9,900.00.

The City will be invoiced monthly based on services performed. With this compensation method you pay only for the hours actually used. The proposed budget is for programming, startup and owner training engineering & programming services.
