Below is a clarification of the bid document.

Question: Your specifications call for 3 skids. In the past the standard skids were only 1.5 inches high by 3 inches wide. Most current container specifications are for 2 skid, 4 inches wide and 3 inches high(same amount of steel as other) but the high skids keep the container out of water/ mud etc and allow to be hosed out underneath the container for varmint and litter control. This has been the preferred design. Is this set up acceptable?

Answer: Per the bid specs, the City is requesting the containers to be built to the specifications as written. There shall be no alternatives with reducing the number of skids that shall be mounted to the bottom of the containers. The dimensions of the container skids shall be consistent with industry standards which are typically 4 inches wide by 3 inches tall.
