Clarifications below are being made for the uploaded documents on the website.

- 1) In Section 1 "Invitation to Bid", delete the pages shown on the attached EXHIBIT A file "Section 1 Deleted Pages" from the bid package. The required information for the bid submittal is located elsewhere in Section 1 or is not applicable to this project.

- 2) In Section 1 Invitation to Bid, page 26 "Notice to Contractors", the second and third paragraphs should read: "For the City of Naples until 2:00 P.M. Local Time, 2/25/2013, at which time and place all bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bids received after the time and date specified will not be considered."

- 3) Written question will be taken until close of business on 2/19/2013. Per the bid document, emailed questions should be sent to ggivens@naplesgov.com .

- 4) Section I (Bidding Documents), Bid Proposal Form, Paragraph 2. Amend Paragraph 2 which reads "That the First Party shall commence the work to be performed under this Agreement on a date to be specified in a written Notice to Proceed of the Second Party, which shall be no later than 15 days from the Notice of Award, and shall fully complete all work hereunder within 180 consecutive calendar days from said date." to read as follows:

"That the First Party shall commence the work to be performed under this Agreement on a date to be specified in written Notice to Proceed #1 of the Second Party, which shall

be no later than 15 days from the Notice of Award, and shall fully complete all work hereunder within 240 consecutive calendar days from said date. Two Notices to Proceed (NTP) shall be issued for this project. NTP #1 shall authorize the Contractor to proceed with acquisition of construction materials, submittal of the required plans and documents, as described in Section V (Technical Specifications), paragraphs 1.0 through 1.9, for review and approval, and agency project pre-construction meetings and City required pre-construction meetings which shall not exceed 60 days. Notice to Proceed #2 authorizing the Contractor to commence work to conduct all construction phase services, as described in the Contract Documents, shall be issued within 60 days of the NTP #1 and construction shall not exceed 180 days. The First Party shall complete all work to be performed under this Agreement within 240 days consecutive calendar days from said NTP #1 date.”

- 5) Section III - Supplemental Standard Special Provisions, Page 2, Paragraph SC-4.4. Delete the first two sentences in their entirety and add the following:

*“Two Notices to Proceed (NTP) shall be issued for this project, including:
NTP #1 authorizing the Contractor to proceed with:*

- a) acquisition of construction materials;*
- b) submittal of the required plans and documents, as described in Section V (Technical Specifications), paragraphs 1.0 through 1.9, for review and approval;*
- c) agency project pre-construction meetings; and,*
- d) City required pre-construction meetings.*

The contract time shall not exceed 60 days for NTP #1.”

“NTP #2 authorizing the Contractor to commence work to conduct all construction phase services, as described in the Contract Documents, upon completion of the NTP #1 items and NTP #2 shall not exceed 180 days.”

- 6) Section V (Technical Specifications), Paragraph 5.1 (Scope), replace the following:

“Replace 3,575 CY with 3,785 CY and replace 16,435 CY with 17,960 CY.”

- 7) Section V (Technical Specifications), add the following sentence at the end of Paragraph 10.6 (Solid Waste):

“All costs associated with disposal of debris or trash taken to an upland site shall be the responsibility of the contractor.”

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Written submitted question #1:

- 1) I have attached a quick sketch of the locations of the various sized tubes specified in the A-A through F-F cross-sections and the longitudinal center line. However, there are some areas that we are unsure of and have labeled them as A-1 through A-6. These areas are found primarily outside the armored limits of the low wetland and the coastal upland where it is specified that the spoils must be wholly contained.

Answer:

1. The permitted area of the habitat island is greater in footprint than the area shown in the construction drawings. The area shown in the construction drawings is based on the anticipated volume of sediment removal and compaction of that sediment.
2. The contractor may elect to utilize containers internal to the design footprint for the dewatering/construction of the habitat island. The use and size of such containers will be based on the means and methods of the contractor.
3. Finished elevations of the habitat island, including the containers, shall be to the lines, grades and elevations as shown on the construction drawings.

Written submitted question #2:

- 2) What are the bid bond requirements?

Answer:

The bid bond requirements are described in Section 1 "Special Conditions" Paragraph F "Bid Performance and Payment Bonds".

Written submitted question #3:

- 3) I have been sourcing rock for the rip rap island perimeter. All my rock subcontractors claim that 150 lb density rock is not to be found in the Naples area. This specification needs to be lowered to 140 lb density rock to source this rock in the Naples area.

Answer:

Limerock density of 150 lb per cubic foot is revised to a density of 138 lb per cubic foot minimum density.

Written submitted question #4:

- 4) Please let me know if I can miss attending the meeting in person and still be eligible to submit a bid for this project.

Answer:

No. The pre-bid in-person meeting attendance is mandatory.

Written submitted question #5:

- 5) In Technical Specification 1.2, the last sentence states:
The contractor is solely responsible for investigating the sediment resources prior to submitting his bid and managing said resources during construction to ensure a sand cap meeting the required

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specifications is constructed. My investigation concludes there is enough sand in the project dredge area to provide this sand if most of the material is processed and sized. In reviewing my pre-bid notes can I conclude that the engineer states that there is enough sand in certain areas and if the contractor follows direction from the engineer as where to dredge for cap material there will be enough sand present to provide this cap material without any processing? In doing so, if it is determined that the material used from these areas for cap material does not meet the minimum requirement for size consistent then the contractor may make a claim for Varying Site Conditions and any costs to remedy this condition will be the responsibility of the Owner (Spearin Doctrine 1918, Owner Impliedly Warrants the Accuracy of the Plans and Specifications).

Answer:

Sufficient quantities exist but it is the responsibility of the Contractor to manage the excavation and conveyance of material to the habitat island in a manner that would prevent loss of the high quality sediment.

Written submitted question #6:

6) Does the City of Naples still want a bid if it is significantly higher than the Engineer's Estimate?

Answer:

Yes. The City understands that the engineers estimate is only an approximation based on best available information. The City encourages all contractors experienced and qualified in this type of a project to provide a bid. All bids will be accepted, as submitted.

Written submitted question #7:

7) Is the contractor responsible for not rupturing the geo-tube fabric while placing the rip-rap?

Answer:

Rock shall not have direct contact with geotextile container and shall require a Mirafi HP 570 woven geotextile fabric underlay or equal.

Written submitted question #8:

8) Will the canal be closed to traffic during the dredging?

Answer:

Boat traffic may be routed outside the Contractor's active work area. During the period of May 1 to December 1, 2013 there will be limited boat use within the canals due to part time residency of Port Royal property owners.

Written submitted question #9:

9) Does the engineer have any suggestions as the manner to secure the geo-tubes under water in tidal currents? Is there any information as to the velocity of the tidal current?

Answer:

The Contractor that is responsible for filling the geo-tubes should have experience in laying out, filling and controlling the position of the containers from setting out to completion of the work.

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Tidal measurements taken throughout one tidal cycle on June 6, 2012 indicated a current velocity range within the vicinity of the habitat island up to 2.0 fps. The Contractor should assume that those rates may be higher.

Written submitted question #10:

10) We estimate 240 days to complete this project. If the current time period is not extended we will have no choice but to add the additional liquidated damages to our price.

Answer:

The time to complete the project has been extended as noted in this addendum.

Written submitted question #11:

11) Is all the material for the oyster reef to come from the dredge area or are we expected to bring in oyster material from an outside source?

Answer:

It is anticipated that all oyster reef material for construction of the habitat island, as referenced in Technical Specification 8.7.8, will be imported.

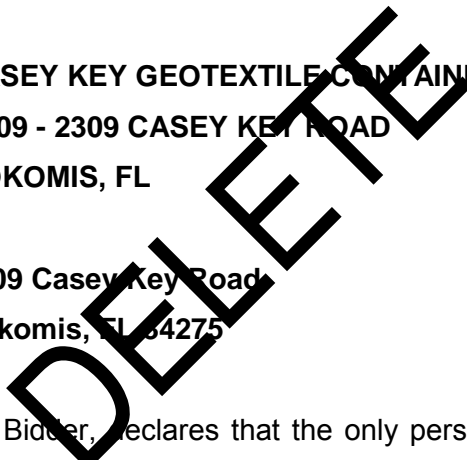

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(7) It is expressly understood that quantities in the Bidding Schedule for Unit Price Items are approximate only, and that payment on a Contract will be made only on the actual quantities of the Work complete in place, measured on the basis defined in the Contract Documents and the Construction Drawings.

(8) The undersigned has carefully checked the above Bidding Schedule against the Construction Drawings and Specifications before preparing this Proposal and accepts the said quantities to be substantially correct, both as to classification and amount, and as correctly listing the complete work to be done in accordance with the Contract Documents and Specifications.

(9) If this Proposal is accepted and the undersigned shall fail to contract as aforesaid, and fails to provide all insurance certificates as required by the Contract Documents, and fails to give the Performance Bond and Payment Bond required by the Standard General Conditions of the Contract by law within ten (10) days after the date of the award of the Contract, the OWNER, at its option, may determine that the bidder has abandoned his Contract and thereupon this Proposal and the acceptance hereof shall be null and void, and the forfeiture of such security accompanying this Proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the OWNER.

In connection with the Work Plan, the Bidder has attached an equipment schedule indicating the tabulation of available equipment to be assigned to the project. Schedules shall include number and types of equipment, capacity, manufacturer, age, condition, and present location.

(12) Bidder understands that the OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any informalities and minor irregularities in the bidding.
