The below question was received for clarification of the bid document.

In regards to the above referenced bid page 13 item # III Labor, requires "load testing" of the
rebuilt unit. The only way to load test this gear drive unit is to attach the City's electric motor
unit to it, install it on-site at the water plant, and operate it coupled to the clarifier. Is that the
intent of this sentence, or are the bidders not expected to load test it, but rather to just
functionally test it in their rebuild shop?
