Received written question is listed below:

1) When and or how can it be arrange for a vendor to review all the different locations/sites including but not limited to the alarm systems to be monitored including all the things mentioned which are to be inspected, tested and maintained to determine cost.

Answer: Please see above submission date clarification. Information on the time and date for the site inspection walk-through will be posted in the next Addendum.

2) Does the City have a written itemized inventory of all items at each of the sites which need to be inspected tested and maintained available for review to determine cost? If not, can the city provide a copy of recent/previous inspection reports for the sites which would show the quantities of all the individual things to be inspected, tested and maintained?

Answer: This item is a requirement of the selected vendor to provide it to the City.

3) What else if anything has been or currently is an issue with any of the four (4) fire alarm systems which may need to be address when replacing them?

Answer: They are proprietary. When replacing a fire alarm system previous or current problems are not applicable. System should be replaced per current code.

4) Can the significant onetime initial cost of permitting and programming a fire alarm system be separated from the monthly monitoring cost and annual test/inspection cost for the Six (6) other locations which are not changing the fire alarm panels? If yes, will the cost schedule form be modified to accommodate the separate item or should a separate sheet be included in the proposal?

Answer: This maybe a possible consideration in future bids.

- 5) I would like to survey the 4 properties that need pricing to install nonproprietary fire alarm systems per page 26 of the RFP. Please let me know what the procedure is to coordinate this.
