RESOLUTION 14-13484

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-14 BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 13-13345 BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY TO FUND THE COST FOR THE DESIGN AND ENGINEERING OF A REPLACEMENT HEATING. VENTILATION AND COOLING SYSTEM FOR THE NAPLES POLICE DEPARTMENT AND FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, LOCATED AT 355 RIVERSIDE CIRCLE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the City adopted a budget in September 2013 by Ordinance 13-13345; and
- WHEREAS, the heating, ventilation and cooling (HVAC) system in the Naples Police Department and Fire-Rescue Department Administration Building is operationally deficient and no longer sustainable; and
- WHEREAS. a request for qualifications to engineer and design a system that will effectively manage the air temperature in the Naples Police Department and Fire-Rescue Department Administration Building was issued: and
- WHEREAS. it is in the City's best interest to appropriate \$66,500 from the General Fund Contingency to contract with Matern Professional Engineering Inc. for this design;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2013-14 budget adopted by Ordinance 13-13345 is amended by appropriating \$66,500 from the Contingency Account of the General Fund which has a current balance of \$332,000 to fund the cost for the design and engineering of a replacement heating, ventilation and cooling (HVAC) system for the Naples Police Department and Fire-Rescue Department Administration Building located at 355 Riverside Circle.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
