RESOLUTION 15-13662

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RENEWAL OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN NAPLES TRANSPORTATION AND TOURS, LLC, AND THE CITY OF NAPLES RELATING TO SIGHTSEEING BUS STOPS AND ROUTES ON CITY STREETS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2010, the City Council pursuant to Resolution 10-12712 approved a non-exclusive franchise agreement with Naples Trolley Tours, LLC, to use City streets and to designate sightseeing trolley/bus stops and routes on City streets for an effective period of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the current transportation service provider, Naples Transportation and Tours LLC, has requested that the agreement be renewed; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has reviewed the services provided under the current franchise agreement and recommends approval of a new agreement for a period of up to five (5) years and incorporating provisions and an operation plan as attached herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:


Section 1. That the renewal of the non-exclusive Sightseeing Bus Stop & Bus Route franchise agreement between Naples Transportation and Tours LLC and the City of Naples is hereby approved, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the non-exclusive Sightseeing Bus Stop & Bus Route franchise agreement.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



EXHIBIT A

SIGHTSEEING BUS STOP & BUS ROUTE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 10th day of June, 2015, by and between the CITY OF NAPLES, NAPLES, FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as "City" or "Grantor"; and the NAPLES TRANSPORTATION & TOURS, LLC, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee";

NOW, THEREFORE, WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the benefits to be derived by the City of Naples and its inhabitants from the operation of a private passenger sightseeing bus route along certain streets within the City limits of Naples and of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The City hereby grants to the Grantee the non-exclusive right and privilege to operate up to two (2) scheduled passenger tour busses, not to exceed thirty-eight feet (38') in overall length, over, across and along designated streets and avenues of the City and into and from suburban communities and territories adjacent to the City, for the purpose of conveying passengers for hire. Special charters shall be in addition to scheduled operations. Sightseeing services to be provided by the Grantee are outlined in the attached 'Operation Plan' which provides routes, stops, schedules, vehicle listing, seasonal operating information and additional operational information. This agreement recognizes the right of the Grantee to provide special charters/destination-to-destination services within the City of Naples subject to either the destinations being private property or the destinations being subject of administrative approval.
2. By virtue of this agreement, Grantee is required to operate said vehicles in a safe and efficient manner conducive to the utmost protection of the public at all times, to obtain all required permits and licenses and to observe all traffic regulations and city, county, state and deferral laws applicable to the operation thereof and to follow the attached 'Operation Plan'.
3. Grantee acknowledges that nothing contained in this agreement waives any defenses the City may have for any liability pursuant to actions of the Grantee. Further, the City does not waive any defenses it may have. Nothing herein is intended to alter any immunity in tort or otherwise impose liability on the City. Nevertheless, Grantee shall save the city harmless from any and all losses, claims for personal injury or death of any person, suits and actions at law of every kind and description arising or resulting from the operation of said vehicle. For this purpose Grantee shall provide for public liability and property damage insurance to be carried in the minimum combined amount of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) covering the use of said vehicles and providing protection against any and all claims for personal injury or death of any person and property damage which may arise out of or in connection with, the operation of said vehicles. The City of Naples shall be named as additionally insured on the insurance policy and certificate of insurance. Grantee shall furnish a copy of the certificate of insurance reflecting said coverage to the City Manager prior to the adoption of this agreement and annually thereafter.

4. Trolley/bus stops and/or loading zones in the public right-of-way designated for use by more than one transportation service company/grantee shall be subject of generic signing per the FHWA Manual on Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and such signing shall be installed by the City. Signing at these stops/loading zones may be supplemented by route/destination/scheduling materials provided by the applicable grantee and approved by the City. Grantee shall not be permitted to install or move trolley/bus stop signs on any City right-of-way. Where bus stops and/or loading zones are used by a single transportation service company/grantee, the grantee shall provide signage to the City for installation. Size, message and color of signs and related materials shall receive prior approval from the City Manager's Office. Grantee shall be responsible for providing additional signs at the single service stops should they become missing.
5. Grantee shall not assign any rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior approval of the City Manager.
6. During the approved operating hours and consistent with approval of the 'Operation Plan' and use of the public right-of-way, Grantee agrees that said vehicles will stop in the public right-of-way only for traffic signals and traffic controls and only at locations where signs are posted designating trolley stops/bus stops/loading zones. Initially approved trolley stop/bus stop/loading zone locations are as follows:
 - 1) Southwest corner of 5th Avenue South & East Lake Drive
 - 2) Tin City Shops via 12th Street South
 - 3) Dockside Boardwalk on 11th Street South
 - 4) Naples City Dock @ the east end of 12th Avenue South.
 - 5) East side of 3rd Street South at 12th Avenues South
 - 6) Southwest corner of the intersection of Fourth Avenue South & 7th Street South
 - 7) Lowdermilk Park
 - 8) Edgewater Beach Hotel on Gulf Shore Boulevard
 - 19) Naples Beach Hotel
 - 10) Northeast corner of 5th Avenue South & 6th Street South

Grantee further agrees to operate said vehicles only over such routes as are approved as part of the 'Operation Plan' and modifications of such plans as may be approved by the City Manager. Such routes may be revised from time to time by the City Manager who is authorized to consent to such changes so long as the routes do not make frequent or undue use of residential side streets within the City nor tend to overcrowd commercial locations and areas of traffic congestion. The City reserves the right to modify the proposed routes, trolley/bus stops in the public right-of-way, and/or schedules to address traffic concerns or otherwise to be in the best interest of the public. Deviation from approved routes or schedules may result in suspension or termination of this Agreement.

The parties agree that the following procedure shall be used to determine penalties against Grantee under this section:

In the event that Grantor receives a confirmed complaint (as hereinafter defined), Grantor shall provide Grantee with written notice of said confirmed complaint. If Grantor receives three confirmed complaints against Grantee in any six month time period, Grantor's notice to Grantee of the third confirmed complaint shall state the same and Grantee's franchise shall be suspended for two (2) days. If Grantor receives four confirmed complaints against Grantee in any six month time period, Grantor's notice to Grantee of the fourth confirmed complaint shall state the same and City Council shall hold a public hearing to consider the revocation of this franchise which revocation may be in the sole and exclusive discretion of City Council.

All notices required by this section shall be in writing and either hand delivered, delivered by overnight courier or facsimile transmission, or mailed through the United States Postal Service by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested. Any notice shall be deemed to be given upon actual receipt in the case of hand delivery, facsimile, or delivery by overnight courier, or four (4) business days after depositing the same in a letter box or by other means placed within the possession of the United States Postal Service, properly addressed in accordance with the foregoing and with the proper amount of postage affixed thereto. In the event of any notice via facsimile transmission, a hard copy shall be sent via regular mail on the day of such transmission.

For the purposes of this Agreement, a "confirmed complaint" shall mean either (i) a complaint received and validated by Grantor that Grantee has violated a provision of this section or (ii) a warning or citation issued by a local law enforcement agency which represents a violation of this section. A log of complaints with respect to Grantee shall be maintained by the City Manager, which log shall include action taken by Grantor. The City reserves the right to incorporate 'comment' forms and/or 'complaint' forms at the various trolley stops/bus stops to obtain operating and service information.


7. Trolleys/buses shall not be permitted to stop at any designated location for more than three (3) minutes unless the stop is a designated loading zone in which case the time shall be no more than five (5) minutes unless a longer time is allowed as part of an approved operations plan.
8. Trolley/bus color schemes shall be submitted to and approved by the City Manager's Office. Advertisements on trolleys shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) of the total exterior dimension of the trolley with such computation being based on the surface area of the four sides of the bus. Each trolley shall have an exterior sign identifying the firm's name and local phone number clearly visible to the public.
9. Grantee shall make a one thousand dollar (\$1000) annual fee payment to the City of Naples to cover administrative costs associated with this Agreement. The first payment shall be made upon execution of this Agreement and subsequent payments shall be made on each anniversary date thereafter.
10. The City Manager's Office reserves the right to request copies of letters from private property owners within the City of Naples which grant permission to stop on their property to load and/or off-load passengers.

11. Grantee agrees to adopt and maintain a drug free workplace policy during the term of this Agreement. Grantee further agrees to implement and monitor driver background and driver evaluations consistent with the attached 'Operation Plan'. the City's Driver Evaluation Policy for all trolley operators employed by Grantee, attached hereto as Attachment #1 and made a part hereof.
12. No alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed, and no live music shall be performed on scheduled trolleys/buses within the City limits. In addition, loud speakers or amplifiers shall be kept at a minimum noise level so as not to disturb the general public and not to exceed decibel levels set forth in the Naples Code of Ordinances.
13. Grantee shall arrange for and insure that said vehicles are properly maintained, repaired and equipped and shall make said vehicles available at reasonable times for inspection by representatives of the City to determine that such repair and maintenance have been performed.
14. The City reserves the right to terminate and cancel this Agreement and all right and privileges of the Grantee hereunder in the event that Grantee violates any provision of this franchise or any determination of City Council made pursuant thereto, or in the event that City Council determines that it is in the best interests of the City to do so. Should the City determine to exercise its right to terminate this franchise, it shall so notify Grantee in writing sixty (60) days prior to termination unless such termination involves safety and public welfare issues in which case notification may be made in writing ten (10) days prior to such termination.
15. This Agreement shall be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of approval and shall be subject to an annual review and approval of the Operation Plan by the City Manager prior to annual renewal.





OPERATIONAL INFORMATION FROM NAPLES TROLLEY TOURS

BACKGROUND: Naples Trolley Tours (NTT), division of Naples Transportation & Tours, LLC has been operating its daily tours in Naples since October 1988. Naples Trolley Tours operates two Trolleys daily from 9:30am to 5:30pm. The narrated historical tours last approximately 2 hours in length, are lead by trained tour guides, and also allow re-boarding privileges for the day so visitors can get off Trolleys during the tour to sightsee, shop, dine, and browse the Naples area.

EXPERIENCE: With 25+ years' operating in the Naples area, NTT has shown its ability to provide upscale tours in a professional manner. NTT was started in 1988 at the request of local Naples hoteliers who liked what our family was doing on Marco Island with the Marco Island Trolley Tours. My late father, Carl Smith, started NTT in 1988 and I took over the family business in 1990. Having operated the daily tours for over 20 years now, I have shown that we can operate to a published schedule and provide top level service. NTT has held the designation of a "AAA Approved Attraction" for over 20 years and is the only tour of Naples that carries this prestigious honor.

NAPLES TROLLEY TOURS INFORMATION:

- A. **Route:** See enclosed map for same route we have operated for 22 years. We have always operated with the City of Naples partnership to maintain as little as possible intrusion into the residential areas. We hold that very high on our standards and as evidenced by little to no problems for 22 years with the residents.
- B. **Trolley Stop Locations:** See enclosed schedule that details current Trolley Stop locations. These locations are chosen with several areas of regard including safety for our riders, access to local downtown businesses, and causing least amount of traffic issues.
- C. **Service commitments to City of Naples:** NTT has continuously operated two Trolleys per day, seven days per week, eight tours per day from 9:30am to 5:30pm, YEAR-ROUND for 22 years. We are able to service each Trolley Stop location once every hour with this schedule. This has provided the level of needed service to accommodate the needs for the visitors to the area.
- D. **Economic impact for City of Naples:** NTT currently has 12 Trolley Stops within the City of Naples, servicing each one eight times per day, for a total of 96 opportunities for our riders/visitors to de-board the Trolleys and

frequent local Naples businesses. This creates a tremendous positive economic impact for the local businesses and the City of Naples.

- E. **Hotels served:** See enclosed brochure that lists all of the hotels served daily in the Naples area. By picking up at these hotels, we are able to bring these visitors into the downtown Naples area daily, eight times per day, so they can visit local businesses and enjoy their stay.
- F. **Hotel partners:** In addition to serving the local hotels listed in our brochure, NTT has contracts as the **transportation preferred provider** with numerous local hotels.
- G. **Destinations in City of Naples:** See enclosed brochure that lists all areas in downtown Naples serviced daily, eight times per day. Our tour is very comprehensive and serves the City of Naples and local businesses extremely well.
- H. **Rate information:** Our tours cost \$25 for adults and \$12 for children for the daily tour (Includes re-boarding passes). This cost is in line with other similar type tours around the country that range from \$20 to \$36 per person.
- I. **Parking provisions:** With our main office located at 1010 6th Avenue South (Experience Naples building), we are able to steer our riders to park at our location to pick up the tour. We pick up the majority of our riders at our location and our hotel partner locations. The Trolley Stop locations in the City are mainly to drop off riders from our tour, then pick them up later so they can finish the tour and get back to where they started.
- J. **Equipment:** We operate two Trolleys daily on our tour, and operate a total of NINE Trolleys in our fleet. This is the ONLY way to adhere to our schedule by having backup vehicles in case of mechanical failure. Our service shop maintains our vehicles to high level, but breakdowns happen for all companies from time to time so it is IMPERATIVE to have adequate backup vehicles. If not, the operator loses all credibility when mechanical situations arise and they cannot maintain a published schedule.
- K. **Trolley charm:** Our Trolleys are the traditional half-open / half-enclosed "all weather" Trolleys. These have the front half of the Trolley with clear (non-tinted) windows and the back half with the clear (non-tinted) curtains that roll up for maximum viewing by the riders. This type of Trolley is considered all weather since there is always a comfortable breeze on the Trolley and allows maximum viewing with no distorted views.
- L. **Tour conductors:** Our Trolley drivers are also the tour conductors. They are well trained "good will ambassadors" that love telling all of the visitors to the area about how great Naples is! Our Trolley conductors narrate about the history of Naples and Southwest Florida, along with letting the visitors know what there is to do and see while they're here. We have riders everyday tell our Tour Conductors how much they enjoyed the tour and how they would have never seen so much had they not taken our tour. We call our service "Transportainment", part transportation and part entertainment.
- M. **Insurance:** See enclosed policy, NTT carries a total combined amount of \$10,000,000 of insurance coverage. This is the standard amount for our

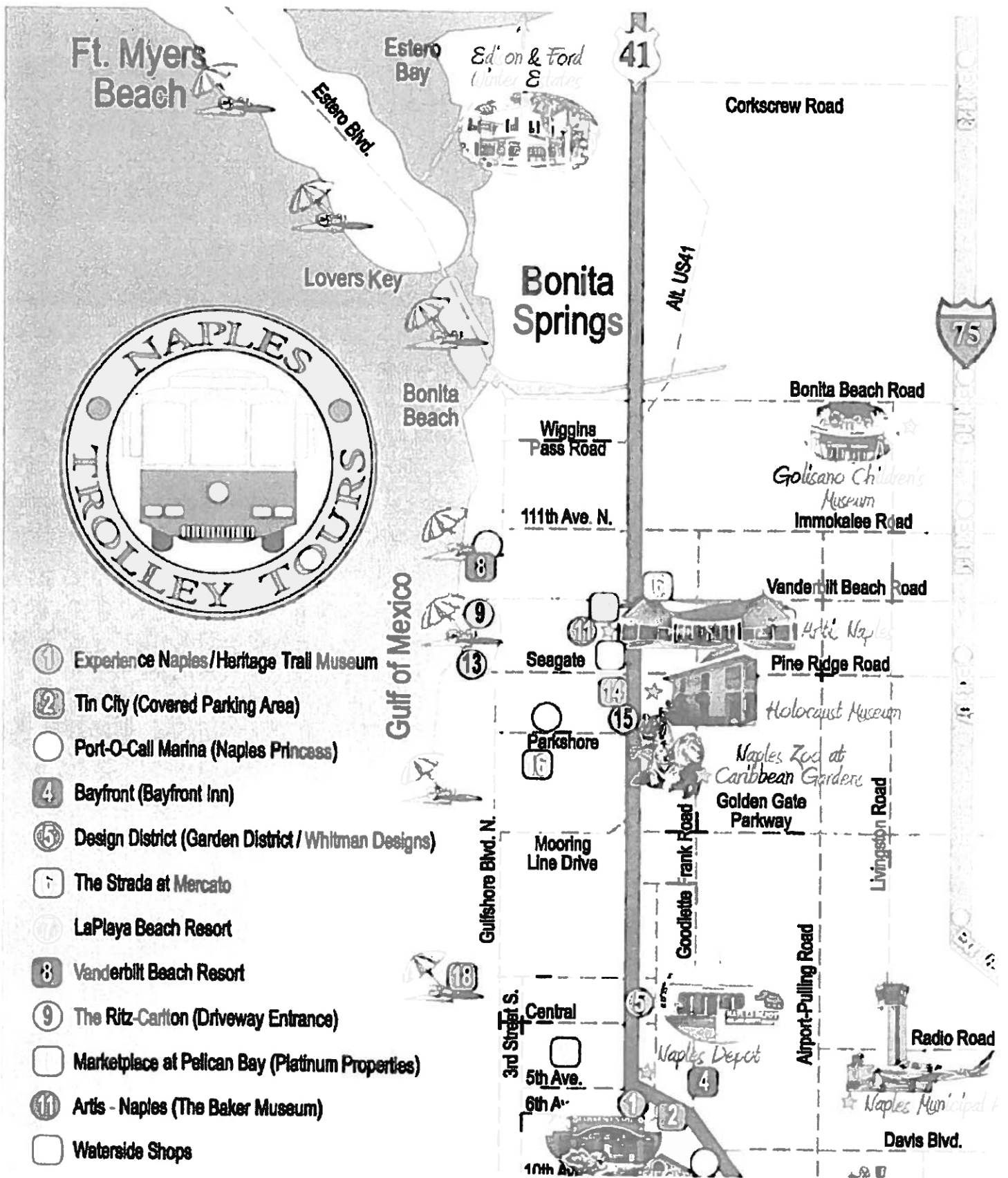
industry and also the amount required by most hotels to do business with them, including the Ritz-Carlton Hotels, Marco Island Marriott Resort, and Sanibel Island Marriott Resort. The City of Naples must require the other Trolley service (and any others) to maintain this level. Since the agreement is for five years, the amount of coverage may be even more than \$10,000,000 for our industry within the next five years.

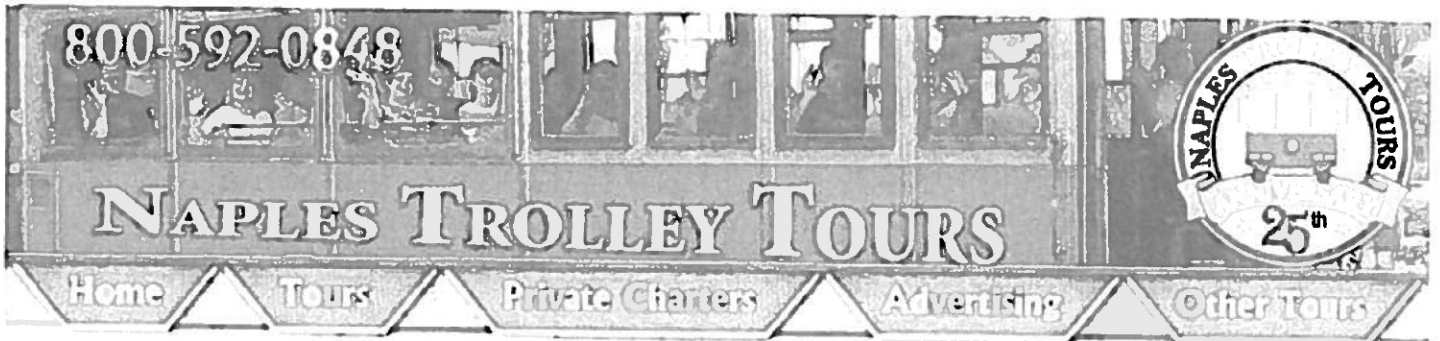
- N. **Safety programs:** NTT maintains a drug free work-place, full coverage for workers' compensation for all employees (including drivers), and a progressive safety program and safety classes.
- O. **Quality assurance and quality control programs:** NTT uses GPS systems in all vehicles that allow operation managers to monitor Trolleys all day. This allows our staff to update callers on where Trolleys are when needed and allows for greater service delivery.
- P. **Staffing:** NTT uses 24/7 dispatchers located in downtown office that monitor Trolleys and communicate with callers when needed. NTT's management consists of the following:
 - 1. CEO- Randy Smith, resident of Naples since 1978, operator of NTT since 1990, former Board Member of Naples Area Chamber of Commerce, Public Vehicle Advisory Committee, FGCU School of Hospitality Advisory Member, numerous charitable organizations.
 - 2. COO- Tamir Rankow
 - 3. CFO- Ron Augustin
 - 4. Sales- Five full time sales associates
 - 5. Operations- Three full time operations managers
 - 6. Dispatch- Four full time dispatch managers
 - 7. Reservations/reception- Two full time associates
 - 8. Accounting- Three full time accounting associates
 - 9. Detailers- One full time and one part time associates
- Q. **Current licenses:** See enclosed for all licenses including City of Naples Occupational License.

NTT has been and continues to be a great provider for the City of Naples. Our daily Trolley Tour has been extremely well received by the visitors to the area, along with the local businesses, and also the residents of Naples.

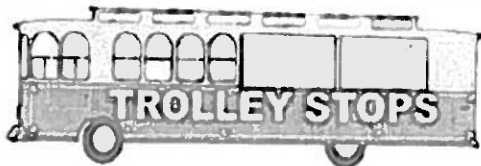

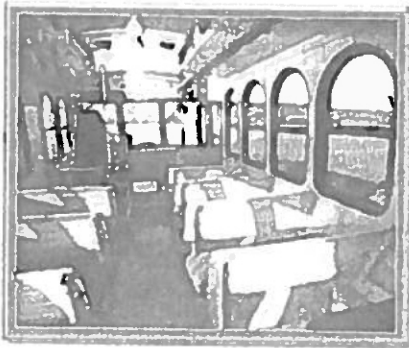
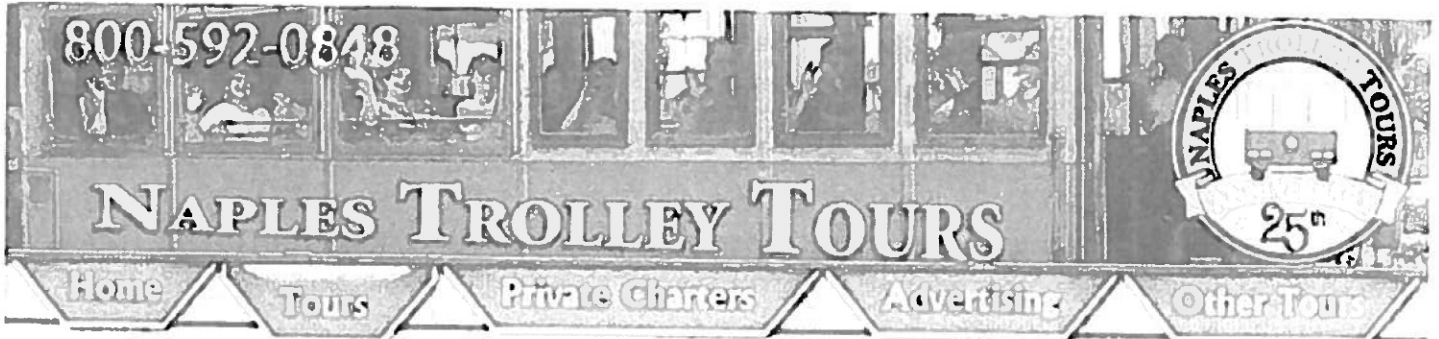
