Meeting of 03/04/15****RESOLUTION 15-13621**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2014-15 BUDGET ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 14-13522 TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE 2 AND 3 OF THE ROYAL HARBOR WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-15 in September 2014 by Resolution 14-13522; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Resolution 14-13522 states that budget adjustments that would increase total expenditures of a budgetary fund or would transfer money between funds require City Council approval via resolution; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2014-15 Capital budget allocated funding within CIP 15L03 in the amount of \$1,645,000 for Phase 2 of the water main improvements located in Royal Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the project was publically bid (City Bid 15-020) and generated a low base bid of \$1,631,193 for both Phase 2 and Phase 3 of the Royal Harbor water main improvements; and

WHEREAS, construction administration services will be required by the Engineer of Record, Tetra Tech, Inc, in a negotiated fee of \$107,555; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$100,000 City controlled contingency has been included within the contract in order to address any unforeseen repairs or construction that may be required to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, total project costs for Phase 2 and 3 equate to \$1,838,748 including the added contingency amount and construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, to fund the full cost of the project, a budget amendment is required to increase CIP 15L03 (Fire Flow Improvements) by transferring \$200,000 from the Water Sewer Fund's Fund Balance in order to fully fund the Royal Harbor water main improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the FY 2014-15 budget of the City of Naples, adopted by Resolution 14-13522, is hereby amended to provide sufficient funding for Phase 2 and 3 of the Royal Harbor water main improvements.


Section 2. That Capital Improvement Project 15L03 is increased to \$1,845,000 by transferring \$200,000 from the Water Sewer Fund's Fund Balance.

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Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
