RESOLUTION 16-13771

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY 2015-16 BUDGET ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 15-13699 TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT FUNDING FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES REQUIRED FOR HORTICULTURAL DEBRIS GENERATED FROM SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS DURING THE WEEK OF JANUARY 17, 2016; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Naples adopted a budget on September 16, 2015 via Resolution 15-13699; and

WHEREAS, severe weather conditions containing high winds impacted the south Florida area during the week of January 17, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the storm event generated significant volumes of horticulture debris within the City that requires removal and disposal; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$51,500 from the Solid Waste Fund's Unrestricted Net Assets to increase the Solid Waste Fund is required to complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:


Section 1. That the FY 2015-16 budget of the City of Naples, adopted by Resolution 15-13699, is hereby amended to provide sufficient funding for the removal and disposal of horticulture debris generated from severe weather conditions during the week of January 17, 2016.

Section 2. That \$51,500 is appropriated from the Solid Waste Fund's Unrestricted Net Assets to increase the Solid Waste Commercial Division's operating budget.


Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


