

RESOLUTION 2017-13911

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FY 2016-17 BUDGET ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 16-13853 BY APPROPRIATING RESERVES FROM THE BEACH FUND FOR MOBILE HANDHELD PARKING ENFORCEMENT DEVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Naples adopted a budget on September 21, 2016 by Resolution 16-13853; and

WHEREAS, the budget did not include funding for mobile handheld enforcement devices; and

WHEREAS, previous mobile handheld enforcement devices were outdated, not compatible with current equipment and have been out of service for several years; and

WHEREAS, mobile handheld enforcement devices will enhance efficiency and accuracy related to beach parking enforcement; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$16,253 from the Beach Fund's Reserves is required to fund the equipment;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:


Section 1. That the FY 2016-17 budget of the City of Naples, adopted by Resolution 16-13853, is hereby amended to appropriate \$16,253 from the Beach Fund's Reserves to create project 17R18 Mobile Enforcement Devices, software and accessories.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
