

City of Naples Utility Rates

Bimonthly Water Base Charge

All City of Naples utility customers, both residential and commercial, are charged a bimonthly base charge, even if no water is used. The rate is based on the meter size.

Bimonthly Water Consumption Charge

In addition to the bimonthly base charge, customers are also charged a bimonthly consumption charge (please see chart, below). This rate is based on meter sizes and the amount of water that is used. Customers with 1-inch meters who use from zero to 15,000 gallons are in Block 1. If their water usage increases from 15,000 to 75,000, then they move to Block 2. It is therefore most beneficial to use lowered amounts of water because the higher blocks are charged at higher rates.

Bimonthly Sewer Service Charge

The base bimonthly charge for single-family and multi-family residences is \$34.36. In addition, each customer is charged a consumption fee, based on the number of gallons of water used. Each single family dwelling has a 20,000 gallon bimonthly cap. The cap does not apply if an irrigation meter, sub-meter, or reclaimed water meter serves the property. No sewer charges are imposed on irrigation water meter flows.

Water Meter Testing

The fee to test a water meter is \$75 for meters 5/8 inch to $1^{"}$. The rate for testing meters 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches and larger varies. Contact the Utilities Department at 213-4745 for additional information.

Late Fees

There is a 5 percent penalty assessed to utility accounts that are paid late

Reinstatement of Water Service

When service has been cut off or discontinued for nonpayment of current bills, service will be reinstated upon prompt payment of unpaid bills, plus a service fee of \$26. When reinstatement is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is \$35. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Reinstatement of Water Service after More than 15 Days

If water service has been discontinued for more than 15 days, by request or otherwise, the service line gate or curb stop valve may be locked in the off position or the meter removed from the premises. Reinstatement after more than 15 days is \$75. If this is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is \$135. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Tenant Utility Deposit

Utility customers who are renters must provide a utility deposit. That rate is double the average utility bill or a minimum of \$200.

Dishonored Checks

Per occurrence, the rate is based on the amount of the check.

Hydrant Service

There is a \$1 per day fee for the hydrant meters out longer than 90 days. The water rate is based on a 2inch water meter, including the base rate.

Solid Waste Collection

The City of Naples provides solid waste collection based on an annual fee established by resolution and in the City Code Chapter 32 and the related Appendix. Commercial services need to review the City Code and contact the City directly for their needs. However, the annual charge for residential property, per the City Code, is \$190.92.
