## monthly Water Consumption Charge

addition to the bimonthly base charge, customers are also charged a bimonthly consumption charge (please see rt , below). This rate is based on meter sizes and the amount of water that is used. Customers with 1 -inch meters use from zero to 15,000 gallons are in Block 1. If their water usage increases from 15,000 to 75,000 , then they ve to Block 2. It is therefore most beneficial to use lowered amounts of water because the higher blocks are charged igher rates.
