monthly Water Consumption Charge

addition to the bimonthly base charge, customers are also charged a bimonthly consumption charge (please see rt, below). This rate is based on meter sizes and the amount of water that is used. Customers with 1-inch meters to use from zero to 15,000 gallons are in Block 1. If their water usage increases from 15,000 to 75,000, then they we to Block 2. It is therefore most beneficial to use lowered amounts of water because the higher blocks are charged higher rates.

Reinstatement of Water Service after More than 15 Days

If water service has been discontinued for more than 15 days, by request or otherwise, the service line gate or curb stop valve will be locked in the off position or the meter removed from the premises. Reinstatement after more than 15 days is \$75. If this is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is \$135. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.
