



City of Naples Utility Rates

Monthly Water Base Charge

City of Naples utility customers, both residential and commercial, are charged a bimonthly base charge, even if no meter is used. The rate is based on the meter size.

Monthly Water Consumption Charge

In addition to the bimonthly base charge, customers are also charged a bimonthly consumption charge (please see chart, below). This rate is based on meter sizes and the amount of water that is used. Customers with 1-inch meters who use from zero to 15,000 gallons are in Block 1. If their water usage increases from 15,000 to 75,000, then they move to Block 2. It is therefore most beneficial to use lowered amounts of water because the higher blocks are charged higher rates.

Reinstatement of Water Service

If service has been cut off or discontinued for nonpayment of current bills, service will be reinstated upon prompt payment of unpaid bills, plus a service fee of \$26. When reinstatement is performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is \$35. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding

Reinstatement of Water Service after More than 15 Days

If service has been discontinued for more than 15 days, by request or otherwise, the service line gate or curb stop may be locked in the off position or the meter removed from the premises. Reinstatement after more than 15 days may be performed outside of normal working hours, per customer request, the fee is \$135. Normal working hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Unpaid Checks

In the event of nonpayment, the rate is based on the amount of the unpaid bill.

Water Service

A \$1 per day fee for the hydrant meters is assessed after 90 days. The water rate is based on the number of hydrant water meters, including the base rate.

Waste Collection

The City of Naples provides solid waste collection based on an annual fee established by resolution and in the City Code Section 22.032 and the related Appendix. Commercial services need to review the City Code and contact the City directly for more information. However, the annual charge for residential property, per the City Code, is \$190.92.
