The City of Naples Solid Waste staff would like to remind customers that residential Garbage, Recycling, and Horticulture collections will be delayed one day—But Only if your normal collection day falls on Thursday or Friday. Thanksgiving week holiday schedule will be the following:

• Monday—November 19, 2012 ——No change



- Tuesday—November 20, 2012 ———No change
- Wednesday—November 21, 2012 —---No change
- Thursday—November 22, 2012 ——-Will be collected on Friday
- Friday—November 23, 2012 ———Will be collected on Saturday

# **Residential Recycling Collection Update !**

Automated collection of the Blue Recycling Carts has begun. Residential customers are asked to become *"Cart Smart"* by following these simple rules and regulations:

## Blue Recycle Cart Collection Rules and Regulations:

- Place Blue Recycle Cart at curb before 7:00 am and remove empty cart from curb before next day.
- Cart must be placed with the lid opening toward the road and no more than 3 feet from curb.
- Cart must have minimum of 4 feet clearance from obstructions such as vehicles and mailboxes.
- Place only recyclable materials inside the cart. (Examples of acceptable materials are posted on each cart lid. If unacceptable material / items are placed in cart, it will not be collected)
- No plastic bags, plastic wrapping or styrofoam products of any kind can be collected.
- All containers must be rinsed free of food or dirt debris before putting them into the cart.
- Extra recycling or large boxes that don't fit into the Blue Cart can be taken to the recycling center located behind the City's Solid Waste operations building at 50 Riverside Circle, or call to schedule a pick up— City of Naples Solid Waste—(239) 213-4700—Monday - Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm
