The City of Naples Solid Waste staff would like to remind customers that residential Garbage, Recycling, and Horticulture collections will be delayed one day—But Only if your normal collection day falls on Thursday or Friday. Thanksgiving week holiday schedule will be the following:

- Wednesday—November 23, 2016 —---No change
- Thursday—November 24, 2016 ——-Will be collected on Friday

Normal collection schedules will resume beginning Monday—November 28, 2016

## **Residential Collection Reminder !**

Residents are reminded that collections will occur anytime between 7:00 am & 5:30 pm on the collection day. Placing recycle carts and horticulture out the night before is acceptable.

- Garbage cans are collected next to the house and must be visible and accessible by 7:00 am. All garbage must be bagged and placed in a trash can no larger than 30 gallons with a tight fitting lid.
- Recycle Carts must be curbside by 7:00 am. The cart must be positioned with lid opening towards the street and a minimum of 4 feet clearance of other obstacles. Plastic bags, plastic wrappings, and styrofoam products are not recyclable.
- Horticulture debris can be piled, bagged in paper yard waste bags, or placed in a trash can without a lid but NO PLASTIC BAGS please. Horticulture needs to be placed curbside by 7:00 am.
- Bulk / Oversize items are collected Monday thru Friday and must be scheduled by calling the Solid Waste office Monday—Friday 8:00 am until 5:00 pm at (239) 213-4700 at least 24 hours in advance. Scheduled items must be placed at curb by 7:00 am.
