

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for repairs to Fleischmann Park in the City of Naples due to Hurricane Irma (DR-4337-FL PW 05839). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 6, 2017 for Hurricane Irma. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

- Floodplain:** The project is located in zone AE and AH per Collier County FIRM Panel # 12021C0391H dated 05/16/2012.
- Proposed Work and Purpose:** The applicant preformed repairs at multiple sites within Fleischmann Park to restore this park to pre-disaster condition. Repairs to the Community Center and Park Restroom building that consisted of sliding doors, ceiling panels, awnings, light poles, wall finish, security cameras, and fencing. Repairs to be completed include the replacement of dance studio flooring, roofing elements, fencing, and scoreboards. No mitigation is included in this project.
- Project Alternatives:** The no-action alternative was considered. This alternative is not feasible as the area could incur further damages, and would limit the functionality of the park. With the no action alternative, continued negative impacts on residents and the community may be experienced. Alternate locations were not considered as the park provides open-space recreational facilities to the community.
