

City of Naples Bald Eagle Policy



Please be advised that it is against the law to disturb Nesting Bald Eagles during Nesting Season
October 1st through May 15th

In compliance with the USFWS Bald Eagle Management and The City of Naples Comprehensive Plan; Conservation and Coastal Management Element C.C.M., Policy 2-18, the following shall be required to obtain Building Permits for work within 660 of an active Bald Eagles nest:

- 1. A Federal permit or monitoring requirements may be required through USFWS for activates within 660 feet of nesting Bald Eagles. A state permit from FWC has been eliminated.
- 2. USFWS provides technical assistance and maintains relative guidelines. To check if a U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service Eagle Permit is needed visit:

- 4. All contractor work must be in compliance with the U.S. Bald & Golden Eagle Protection Act (https://www.fws.gov/law/bald-and-golden-eagle-protection-act)
- 5. Contractor shall sign the following statement in the presence of a notary:

Contractor for Permit# understands that they must comply with all requirements of the U.S. Bald & Golden Eagle Protection Act and all other laws rules and regulations regarding eagle disturbance. The contractor shall obtain all required permits from the USFWS for the permitted work.
