### Regulations and Information:

- 1. Required plan size is 24" x 36" maximum. Plans must be to scale with a minimum of 3/16"=1'-
- 2. A Chickee may not be enclosed, must be constructed of natural materials, may not obstruct the view or interfere with the privacy of an adjacent neighbor, and may be used only to provide shade or serve as a decorative architectural element.
- 3. A Chickee may not be used as a carport, storage shed, boat shelter, or the like.
- 4. A Chickee located in a commercial area will have additional requirements (Contact 213-1050).
- 5. Projects west of the Coastal Construction Control Line require a permit from the FL Department of Environmental Protection. Coastal Construction Variance from the Natural Resource Director may also be required.
- 6. Contact the respective property owners association for deed restrictions on any exterior work.

#### Fees:

- 1. The fee for this permit is \$0.30 per square foot of the gross square footage of the structure, with a minimum fee of \$100.00. A plan review fee, equal to 15% of permit fee, will be due at time of application. The plan review fee is not refundable, nor is it credited to any other fee.
- 2. Zoning review fee: \$50.00, or \$0.05 per square foot of affected enclosed space, whichever is greater, for permits that include new or renovated square footage.

Recorded Notice of Commencement must be posted if the project valuation exceeds \$2,500.00 WARNING TO OWNER: YOUR FAILURE TO RECORD A NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT MAY RESULT IN YOUR PAYING TWICE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO YOUR PROPERTY. IF YOU INTEND TO OBTAIN FINANCING, CONSULT WITH YOUR LENDER OR AN ATTORNEY BEFORE RECORDING YOUR NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT.

### Contractor's Affidavit:

I certify that all the foregoing information is accurate and that all work must be done in compliance with all applicable laws regulating construction and zoning. I understand **THERE WILL BE A FINAL INSPECTION** of the work permitted herein. Compliance will be strictly enforced. **No work whatsoever will commence until the building permit has been issued.** 

- The permit fee will be quadrupled if work is started without an approved permit.
- The permittee further understands that only licensed contractors may be employed and that the structure shall not be used or occupied until a Certificate of Occupancy/Completion is issued.
