RM1	12.1	At the intersection of the centerlines of Tenth Street and Twenty-eighth Avenue North. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.
RM2	9.1	At the intersection of the centerline of Fourteenth Street and Twenty-second Avenue North. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.
RM3	5.9	At the intersection of the centerlines of Windward Way and Law Line Drive. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.
RM4	8.9	At the intersection of the centerlines of Mooring Line Drive and Crayton Road. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.
RM5	5.7	At the intersection of the centerlines of Ixora Lane and Ixora Drive. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.
RM6	10.6	At the intersection of the centerline of Coral Drive and Hibiscus Road. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey or Florida Geological Survey.

***EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
AD	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depth are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depth of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depth are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; on certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile or areas protected by levees from the base flood (Medium shading).
C	Areas of minimal flooding (No shading).
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (Zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.

This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.

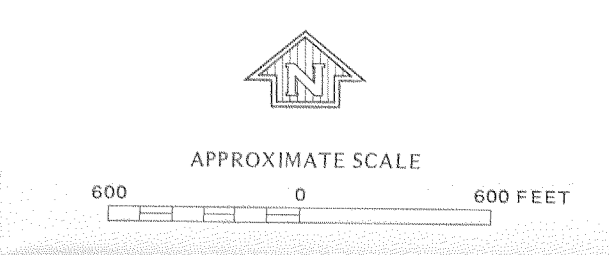
