- 1. Know your flood hazard.
- 2. Insure your property for your flood hazard.
- 3. Protect people from the hazard.
- 4. Protect your property from the hazard.
- 5. Build responsibly.
- 6. Protect natural floodplain functions.

## FLOOD RESPONSE

To help the City's residents be better prepared for the response phase of future flooding, a list of websites/resources has been compiled. In the event of a flooding event, it is crucial that citizens:

- Be mindful of the water level and do not try to drive through flood waters.
- Stay away from any downed power lines.
- Exercise extreme caution upon entering a flooded building. Many hazards may be present.
- Check with local building officials to see if necessary, repairs will require permits. ONLY HIRE LICENSED CONTRACTORS FOR REPAIRS.
- Make preparations knowing that public utilities/phone services will be interrupted for an undetermined period.
- Keep debris out of stormwater drainage structures.
- Document property damage with photos. Try to contact your insurance claim representative.
- Stay somewhere safe refrain from sight-seeing.
