

NAPLES DESIGN DISTRICT 41-10 MASTER PLAN Charrette Meetings:

The Charrette week will feature a series of public sessions moderated by DPZ.

The **Day Sessions** will focus on specific topics and stakeholder groups, while the **Evening Sessions** will offer daily project updates. *Please refer to the Charrette Schedule for more details; below are the dates and times for the day sessions.*

Day Sessions

Meetings 1 and 6 are primarily intended as internal working sessions between the designers, the CRA leadership & City Staff, but are open to anyone who wishes to sit in and listen. The other daytime meetings are meant to be more interactive with the public, and will address the following topics:

Meeting 2—Business Owners: Retail & Restaurants (Wednesday, November 10th at 11 am EST)

- Presentation of the District's Retail Market Analysis by Bob Gibbs of Gibbs Planning Group.
- DPZ-led follow-up discussion.
- *Expected attendees:* Current District tenants and future operators in the commercial/retail and restaurant trades who wish to share their ideas and concerns.

Meeting 3—Property Owners (Thursday, November 11th at 11 am EST)

- DPZ-led discussion
- *Expected attendees:* Area property owners who wish to share their ideas and concerns.
- Presentation of "New Retail Trends in the Post-Covid Economy" by Bob Gibbs (12 noon)

Meeting 4—Infrastructure: Transportation & Stormwater Mgt. (Friday, November 20th at 11 am EST)

- Presentation by Langan Engineering on their analysis of the District's drainage, traffic patterns, intersection improvements, parking, pedestrian & cycling safety, as well as FDOT proposals for US41.
- DPZ-led follow-up discussion
- *Expected attendees:* City Staff, residents, and users of the District who wish to share their ideas and concerns regarding infrastructure needs.

Meeting 5—Residents & Family Open House (Saturday, November 13th at 11 am EST)

- This weekend session is intended as an opportunity for the residents of the area and families with children to drop by and share their thoughts.
- *Expected attendees:* Naples area residents who live in or frequent the District.
- Kids (of all ages) who attend will be encouraged to draw their ideas!

Evening Sessions
