

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ORDINANCES

NOTICE is hereby given that the Naples City Council will consider enactment of the following ordinances upon Second Reading at the Regular City Council meeting to be held on Wednesday, March 19, 2014, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, in the City Council Chamber, 735 Eighth Street South, Naples, Florida:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FILLING LAKES; AMENDING SECTION 52-92 (e), FILLING LAKES; ERECTING BUILDINGS OVER LAKE, OF CHAPTER 52, RESOURCE PROTECTION STANDARDS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NAPLES, IN ORDER TO AMEND THE FILLING PERMIT PROCESS AND PROVIDE BETTER PROTECTION FOR THE WETLAND HABITAT OF LAKES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION SITE REGULATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 16-291 (b) (10) d, CONSTRUCTION SITE MANAGEMENT, OF CHAPTER 16, CONSTRUCTION, REHABILITATION AND PROPERTY MAINTENANCE REGULATIONS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NAPLES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DELETING THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE ON-SITE SEISMIC MONITORING DURING CONSTRUCTION AND ADDING THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE ON-SITE SEISMIC MONITORING DURING PILE DRIVING; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

All interested parties are invited to appear and be heard with respect to said proposed ordinances.
