

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ORDINANCES**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Naples City Council will consider enactment of the following ordinances upon Second Reading at the Special City Council meeting to be held on Wednesday, February 6, 2013, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, in the City Council Chamber, 735 Eighth Street South, Naples, Florida:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 54, SUBDIVISIONS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NAPLES, TO ADD SECTION 54-7, ZERO LOT LINE SUBDIVISIONS, TO PROVIDE STANDARDS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF PROPERTY FOR INDIVIDUALLY OWNED ATTACHED DWELLING UNITS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISIONS 9 THROUGH 14 OF ARTICLE II, ZONING DISTRICT, CHAPTER 58, ZONING OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NAPLES TO PROVIDE ALTERNATE SIDE YARD REQUIREMENTS FOR SINGLE FAMILY HOMES IN MULTIFAMILY DISTRICTS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 46-39, APPROVAL OF TEMPORARY USES AND SPECIAL EVENT ACTIVITIES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NAPLES, TO REVISE AND CLARIFY THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING TEMPORARY USES AND SPECIAL EVENTS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 58-116, MINIMUM YARDS, SECTION 58-121, PIER LOCATION AND DIMENSIONS, AND SECTION 58-122, SEAWALLS, BOAT SLIPS AND REVETMENTS OF ARTICLE II, CHAPTER 58 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, NAPLES, FLORIDA, AS THEY PERTAIN TO THE R1-15A, RESIDENCE DISTRICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Said proposed ordinances may be inspected by the public at the office of the City Clerk, Room B, City Hall, 735 Eighth Street South, Naples, Florida.

All interested parties are invited to appear and be heard with respect to said proposed ordinances.
