NOTICE is hereby given that the Naples City Council will consider enactment of the following ordinance upon Second Reading at the Regular City Council meeting to be held on Monday, November 19, 2018, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be practicable, in the City Council Chamber, 735 Eighth Street South, Naples, Florida:

A ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES; AMENDING CHAPTER 36 - TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III - STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, DIVISION 1 - GENERALLY, SECTION 36-61(d); DIVISION 2. - PROHIBITED PARKING, SECTION 36-103, DELETING SECTION 36-104 AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 36-104; AMENDING CHAPTER 56 - SUPPLEMENTAL STANDARDS, ARTICLE III. - STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS BY DELETING SECTION 56-86; PROVIDING A SEVERABLITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER PROVISION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
