South Golf Drive Improvements Project

October 2021

BACKGROUND

South Golf Drive has a considerable history of residents petitioning to the Council since the early 2000's to address speeding and traffic issues. Passive traffic calming measures such as speed limit pavement markings, solar-powered speed warning signs, and a series of speed tables have been implemented over the years. In 2014, the City requested funding from the Florida Department of Transportation, through the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), to apply a more active and comprehensive solution to the traffic and mobility issues within the South Golf Drive corridor. The funding for the design of a solution is currently available.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The City of Naples contracted with Kisinger Campo & Associates to design a safe road for all users along South Golf Drive, approximately 0.71 miles, between Gulf Shore Boulevard North and US 41. This work includes surveying, engineering, permitting, utility coordination, and public involvement. Elements of the design, which will be guided by a comprehensive public involvement process, will address pedestrians, bicyclists and motor vehicles, traffic calming, landscaping, stormwater management, and parking considerations, including restrictions.

The project requires close collaboration and involvement with the City's Beach Outfall Removal project, adjacent property owners along S. Golf Drive, neighborhood associations, and other Naples residents and stakeholders; all in an effort to build consensus for an environmentally sensitive project that preserves Naples' small town character and culture. Also, to minimize disruption to the community, the project will be planned in close coordination with the redevelopment of the Naples Beach Hotel Resort.

Items of Interest Along South Golf Drive Include:

- Pedestrian safety and connectivity
- Bicycle safety and connectivity
- Stormwater management
- Lane width requirements and alignment
- Driveway connections
- Parking restrictions
- Landscaping and opportunities to increase the availability of shade when appropriate
- Utilities
- Streetscape, including street lighting

Public input is very important in the design of the South Golf Drive project.

Comments received from the public meeting and incorporated into the design include: no parking on either side of the street, include a sidewalk on the north side, prefer the new swale design, do not take two feet from resident's property, and the eight feet of permeable path with lighting is preferred.
