NOTICE OF ZONING IN PROGRESS  
REGULATIONS RELATED TO LOT COMBINATIONS**

Please take Notice that the Naples City Council has declared Zoning In Progress to allow the City of Naples time to consider amendments to **Chapter 54 entitled Subdivision Standards of the City of Naples, Code of Ordinances to provide new and amended standards and criteria for lot combinations and lot reconfigurations**, which will better promote implementation of the City of Naples Comprehensive Plan's policies and goals. The City will continue to accept applications for development site plans, building permits and other applications that are subject to lot coverage calculations for the duration of this Zoning In Progress under the City's existing regulations. It is the intent of the City Council to place applicants and purchasers on notice that submittal of any application is at their own risk and without the benefit of estoppel or vested rights protection during this Zoning In Progress. While this Zoning In Progress is in effect, purchasers and applicants remain on notice and shall not rely on existing standards and criteria in the Land Development Code in making any investment backed decision(s) concerning the development and use of their property.

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

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
