Pursuant to Sec. 2-52 – Special Meetings, I am requesting a special meeting of the Naples City Council on May 1, 2023. The subject items to be discussed at the special meeting are:

- 5. A resolution for the purpose of amending the fiscal year 2022- 2023 budget adopted by Resolution 2022-14943 in the amount of \$277,900 to appropriate funds from the general fund to provide sufficient funding for hardwood and palm tree trimming and amending the 3-year contract with Davey Tree Expert Company, Resolution 2022-14978, to increase the contract amount from \$1,950,000 to \$2,227,900; and providing an effective date.

Resolutions for the purpose of 1) approving an agreement with Sea and Shoreline, LLC in the amount of \$357,802.50, which includes a \$32,527.50 (10%) city-controlled contingency, for the construction of ten oyster reefs at site 2 in Haldeman creek; authorizing the city manager to execute the agreement; and providing an effective date; 2) approving a memorandum of agreement between the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the city of Naples, Florida establishing a partnership for the Naples Bay-Haldeman Creek oyster reef restoration project; acceptance of shell and rock materials from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission with a value up to \$69,000; authorizing the Mayor to execute the Memorandum of Agreement; and providing an effective date and 3) approving agreement No. 4600004754 between the South Florida Water Management District and City of Naples accepting a contribution of funds in the amount of \$110,000 for payment towards construction of ten oyster reefs at site 2; authorizing the Mayor to execute the Agreement; and providing an effective date.
