### New Request for Vote-By-Mail Required for all Registered Voters

*Deadline: March 7, 2024*

**Naples, FL (January 3, 2024)** – Due to changes in Florida law, current requests for a vote-by-mail ballot expired as of January 1, 2023. Voters who vote by mail must submit a new request for the upcoming 2024 Naples General Election no later than March 7, 2024 if you wish to vote-by-mail in the City of Naples 2024 General Election on March 19, 2024. There are several ways to renew your request:
