**PUBLIC NOTICE OF A NAPLES CITY COUNCIL
EXECUTIVE SESSION**

The Executive session is expected to last approximately 1 hour. The purpose of the Executive Session is to discuss settlement negotiations and strategy related to litigation expenditures. The City Council may take action concerning settlement negotiations once the Executive Session is concluded and the public meeting is reopened.
