Resident and Visitors,

As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all, we would like to remind everyone of the following guidelines at the Naples City Dock:

- Alcohol Consumption: The consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the Naples City Dock, All alcoholic beverages must be consumed onboard the vessel. (*City* of Naples Code of Ordinances, Chapter 28, Article II, Section 28-34)
- Pet Regulations: For the safety and comfort of all visitors, all pets must be secured on a leash while walking around the facility. Pets may be off leash while confined to the vessel. It is the responsibility of pet owners to clean up after their pets and ensure they do not harass wildlife or other persons. (*City of Naples Code of Ordinances, Chapter 28, Article II, Section 28-35*)
- **Smoking Policy**: Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited within the facility and on the premises for obvious safety concerns as well as the comfort of all guests. While smoking is permitted on your vessel, it is not allowed near the Fuel Dock, under the Gazebo or on any structure at the Naples City Dock. (City of Naples Code of Ordinances, Chapter 28, Article II, Section 28-37)

We kindly ask for your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines to maintain a pleasant environment for everyone. Your compliance ensures the safety, cleanliness, and enjoyment of the Naples City Dock for all visitors and tenants.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are your operating hours?

A: The Naples City Dock's hours of operation are 7:00am to 5:00pm seven days a week. The only day the City Dock is closed is Christmas Day.

Q: Is the Naples City Dock open to the public?

A: The Naples City Dock is open to the public between the hours of 7:00am and 11:00pm. Outside of the posted hours, only vessel owners are permitted in the facility.

Q: Where do we park and is it free to park?

A: Parking is free to the public unless posted otherwise at the base of the facility as well as overflow parking in the lot located on the southeast corner of the intersection of 8th Street South and Broad Avenue South. If you are getting picked up by a boat that is NOT one of our Charter Captains, there is a \$10.00 fee per passenger.

Q: How close is the Naples City Dock to "Downtown Naples"?

A: Located at the traffic circle of 8th Street South and 12th Avenue South, we are within one half mile of both 5th Avenue and 3rd Street shopping and dining districts with plenty other options in the nearby area.

Q: What are the dockage rates?

0000 A: Annual dockage rates are \$20.00/foot billed as the greater of the vessel or the slip on a monthly recurring cycle. Transient dockage reservations can be made up to three months in advance at \$3.25/foot per night.

Q: What is the longest I can stay as a transient vessel?

A: The State of Florida does not permit "liveaboards" at the facility meaning the vessel cannot be occupied five (5) nights consecutively, or ten (10) total nights within a thirty (30) day period.

Q: Do you have charters that go out of the Naples City Dock? A: Yes, we have Fishing, Sailing, and Sightseeing charters as well as a Water Shuttle that offers all types of excursions. Bookings and payment are made independently through the business.

Q: What types of fuel does the Naples City Dock offer? A: We have 90-Octane Ethanol-Free gasoline as well as ULSD Off-Highway Dyed Diesel fuel.

Q: How many slips does the Naples City Dock have?

A: We have a total of 78 wet slips. 48 are available to recreational boaters on an annual license agreement, 9 are available to the recreational public on a nightly/transient reservation, and the remaining slips are used for commercial charter vessels and fueling.

Q: Do you have monthly/seasonal dockage available? A: No, the two dockage types we offer are transient dockage at a nightly rate or an annual dockage with a 1-year term.

Q: What amenities does the Naples City Dock offer?

A: At the facility, we have restrooms and showers located halfway down the "Charter Dock". In the same building, we have laundry machines that are available for a small fee. The restrooms and showers are for transient customers and tenants only.

Q: How do I inquire about the waiting list for annual dockage? A: The waiting list application can be found at <u>https://www.naplesgov.com/cdw/page/city-dock-forms</u> - At this time, the waiting list is around 90-total names with an expected wait time of about 5-6 years.

Q: What types of vessels can the Naples City Dock accommodate? **A:** On the annual dockage, we can accommodate all vessels up to 60-feet in length. With the transient dockage, we can accommodate all vessels that are able to navigate through the 7-9 foot controlling depth of the waterways.

Q: Can you fish or net for bait on the Naples City Dock?

A: Fishing and bait netting of any kind are not permitted at the Naples City Dock. There are fish cleaning tables located at the Fuel Dock for public use.

Q: What type of payment do we accept?

A: Checks, cash, and all major credit cards are accepted (Visa, Mastercard, Amex, Discover).

Q: How can I use the mooring field?

A: The mooring field is available for \$20.00 per night on a first-come, first-served, basis. The maximum length of stay on the field is four consecutive nights or eight total in a 30-day period. Limitations to vessels looking to use the mooring field are a maximum of 43-feet overall length, 18.5-feet at the beam and 6-feet at the draft.

Q: What do you have for sale in the Ship Store?

A: The Naples City Dock sells live shrimp by the dozen as well as frozen herring, squid, and chum blocks. We also sell snacks and an assortment of fishing tackle, but no rods or reels.
