**RESOLUTION 2017-14063**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 BUDGET ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 2017-14027 BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE FUND BALANCE OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE TAX TO IMPROVE THE POLICE-FIRE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING TO MEET CATEGORY 3 AND BALLISTIC-RESISTANT STANDARDS, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE POLICE BUILDING HARDENING PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Naples adopted a budget on September 20, 2017 via Resolution 2017-14027; and

**WHEREAS,** the Police-Fire Administration Building does not currently meet the Florida Building Code Standards to withstand a Category 3 Hurricane; and

**WHEREAS,** the Police-Fire Administration Building currently houses the City's Emergency Operations Center; and

**WHEREAS,** the first-floor windows of the Police-Fire Administration Building do not currently meet Underwriters Laboratory (UL) standards for ballistic resistant windows; and

**WHEREAS,** staff recommends the budget be amended by an appropriation of \$309,315.00 from the Fund Balance of the Public Service Tax Fund to increase the Community Services budget for the Police Building Hardening Project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** That the FY 2017-18 budget of the City of Naples, adopted by Resolution 2017-14027 is hereby amended by appropriating \$309,315.00 from the Public Service Tax Fund Balance for the Police Building Hardening Project.


**Section 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

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
