

**RESOLUTION 2021-14666**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 BUDGET, ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 2020-14529, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUND BALANCE AND RESERVE OF THE CITY DOCK FUND TO MEET FUEL EXPENSES RESULTING FROM INCREASED SALES AND REVENUE IN FISCAL YEAR 2020-21; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-21 revenue from fuel sales at the City Dock is expected to exceed the estimated budget by over One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) through September 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, in FY 2020-21 fuel expenses related to purchasing fuel for sale will exceed the authorized budget by One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) through September 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2020-21 budget requires amendment to increase appropriations from the Dock Fund unappropriated balance and reserve to meet this obligation;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** That the FY 2020-21 budget of the City of Naples, adopted via Resolution 2020-14529, is hereby amended to appropriate \$110,000 from the unappropriated balance and reserve of the City Dock Fund to the fuel expense account.

**Section 2.** That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


