## **RESOLUTION 2022-14822**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2021-22 BUDGET ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION 2021-14713 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE COST OF A NEW STREETLIGHTING INSTALLATION IN THE SEAGATE NEIGHBORHOOD; AND **PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

WHEREAS, the City adopted a budget in September 2021 via Resolution 2021-14713; and

- WHEREAS, at the January 17, 2022 workshop meeting of the City Council, staff was directed to further evaluate the cost of installing streetlighting, or renting from Florida Power & Light (FPL), in the Seagate neighborhood; and
- WHEREAS, staff's analysis of the costs and comparing the net present value show significant cost savings by purchasing and maintaining the streetlights; and
- WHEREAS, staff has obtained quotes for the work in the amount of Three Hundred Twelve Thousand, Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$312,750); and
- WHEREAS, the Streets Fund Balance has sufficient funds to provide said funding; and
- WHEREAS, City Council has determined the funding for the installation shall be provided by the Streets Fund Balance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the 2021-22 budget of the Streets Fund is amended by appropriating \$312,750 in the streetlighting operating account from the unappropriated fund balance of the Streets Fund.

That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption. Section 2.
